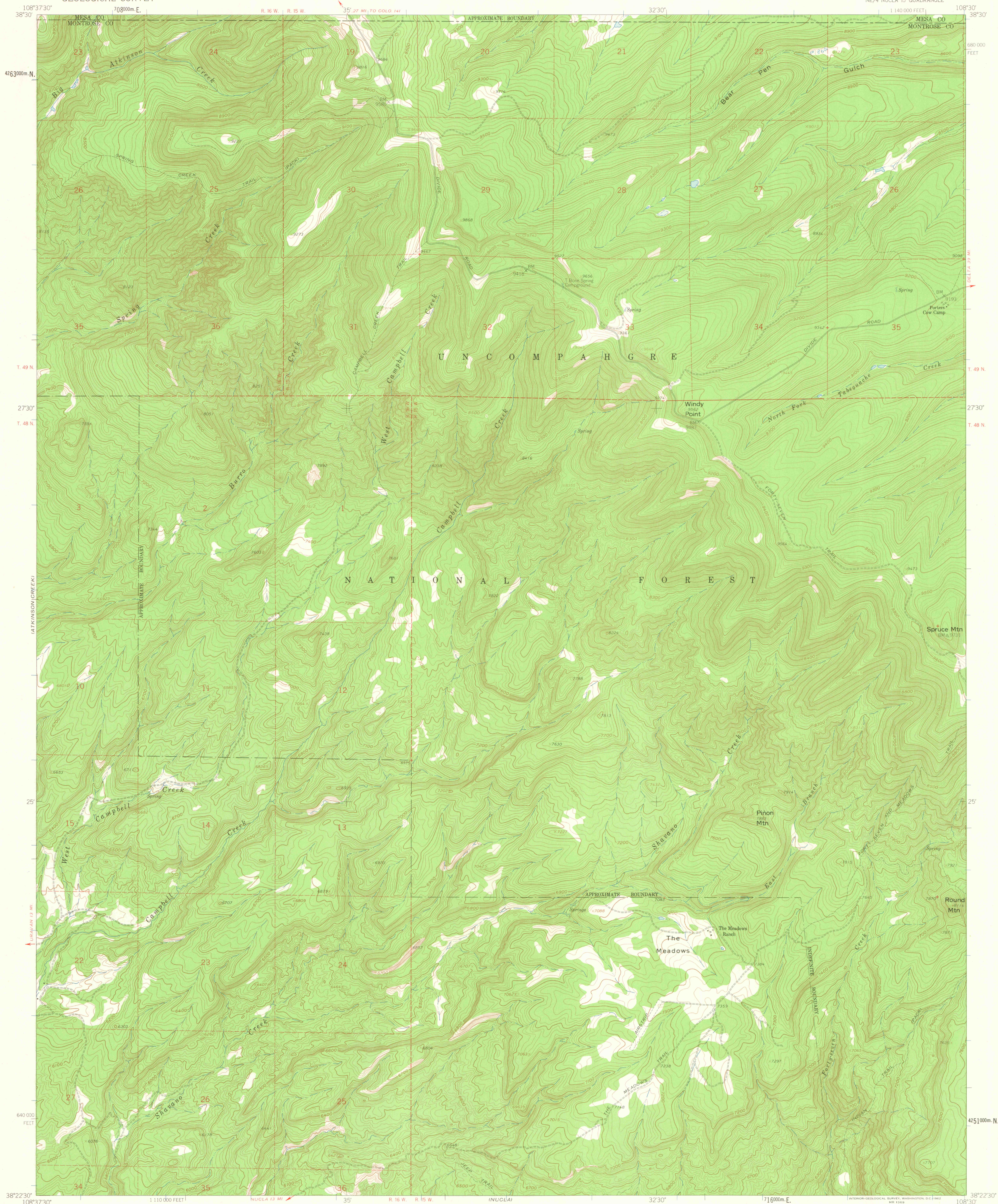
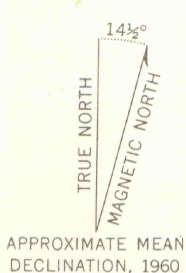

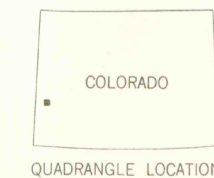
WINDY POINT QUADRANGLE
