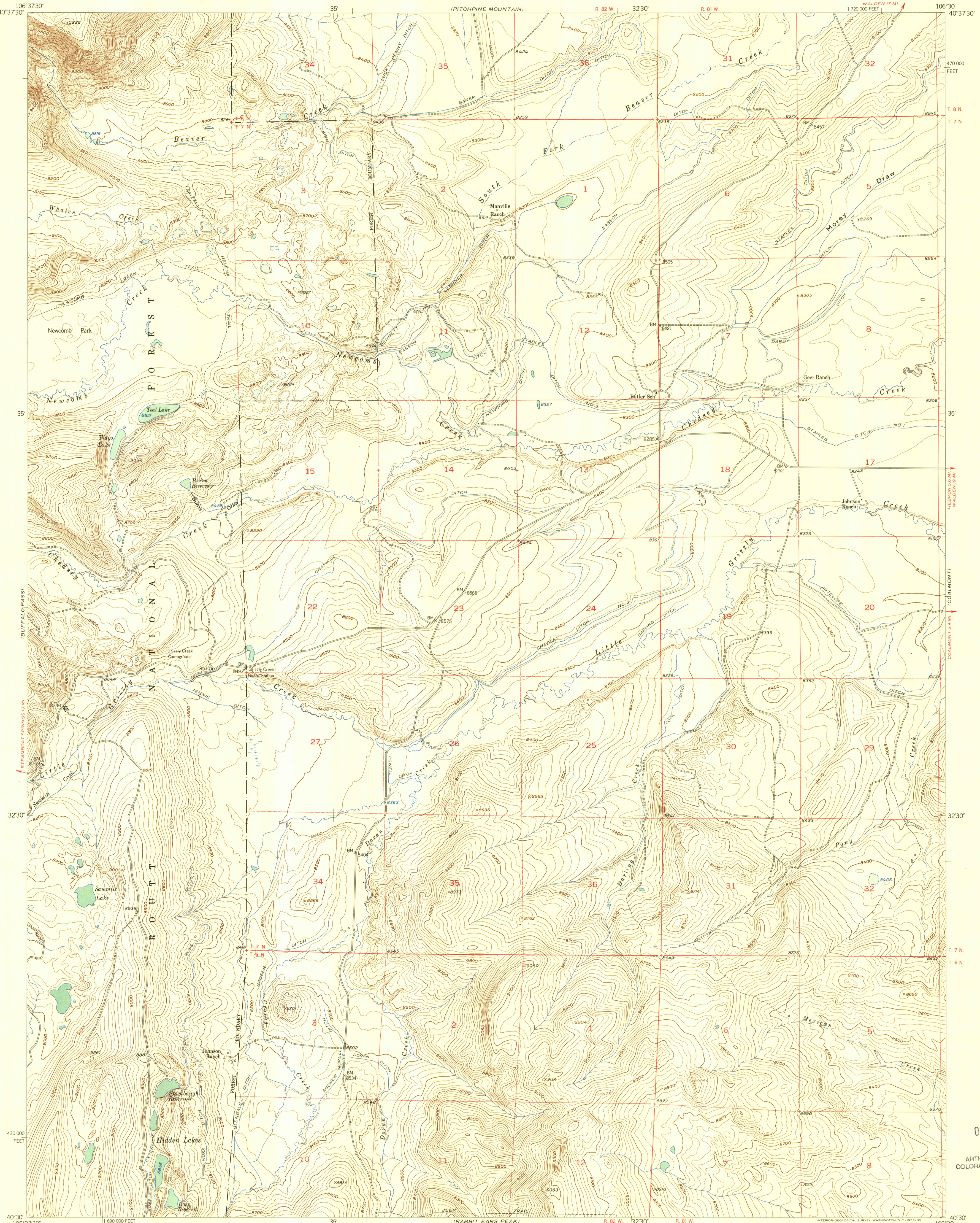

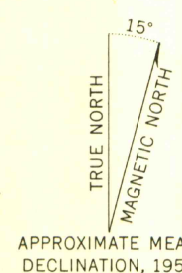

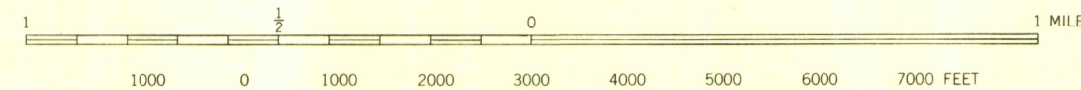

SCALE 1:24,000



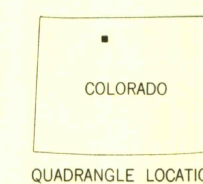
