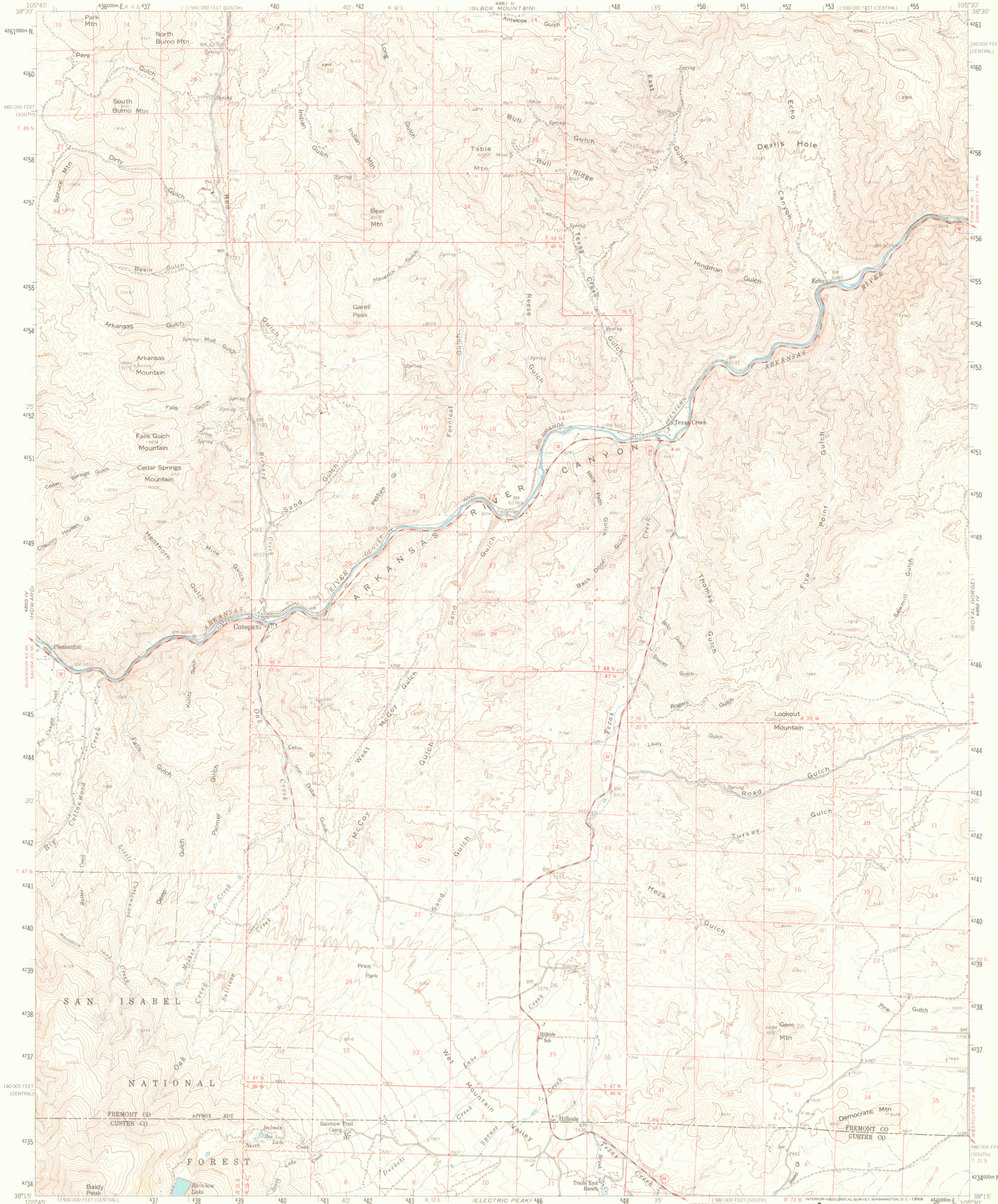
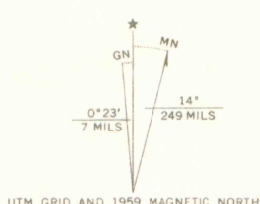

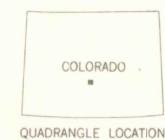
COTOPAXI QUADRANGLE
