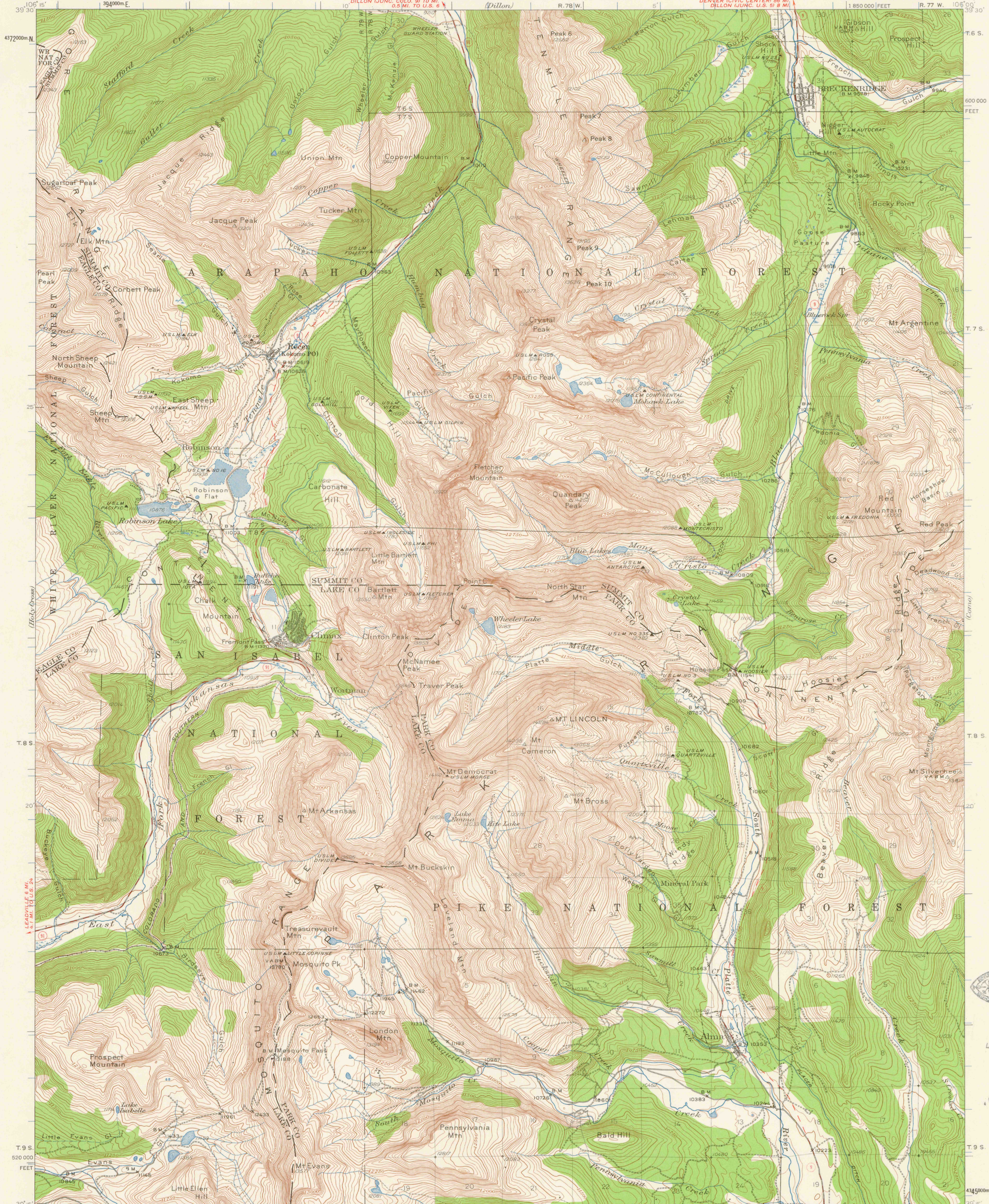


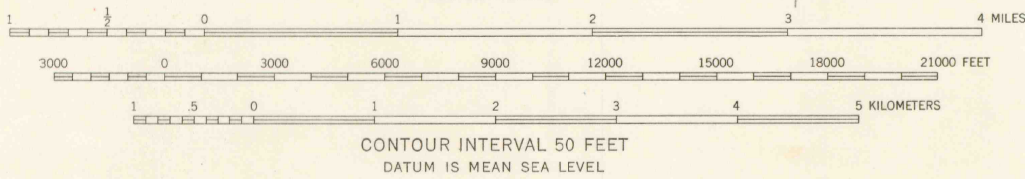

DECLINATION, 1938

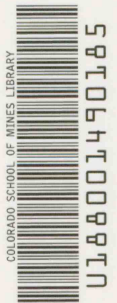
