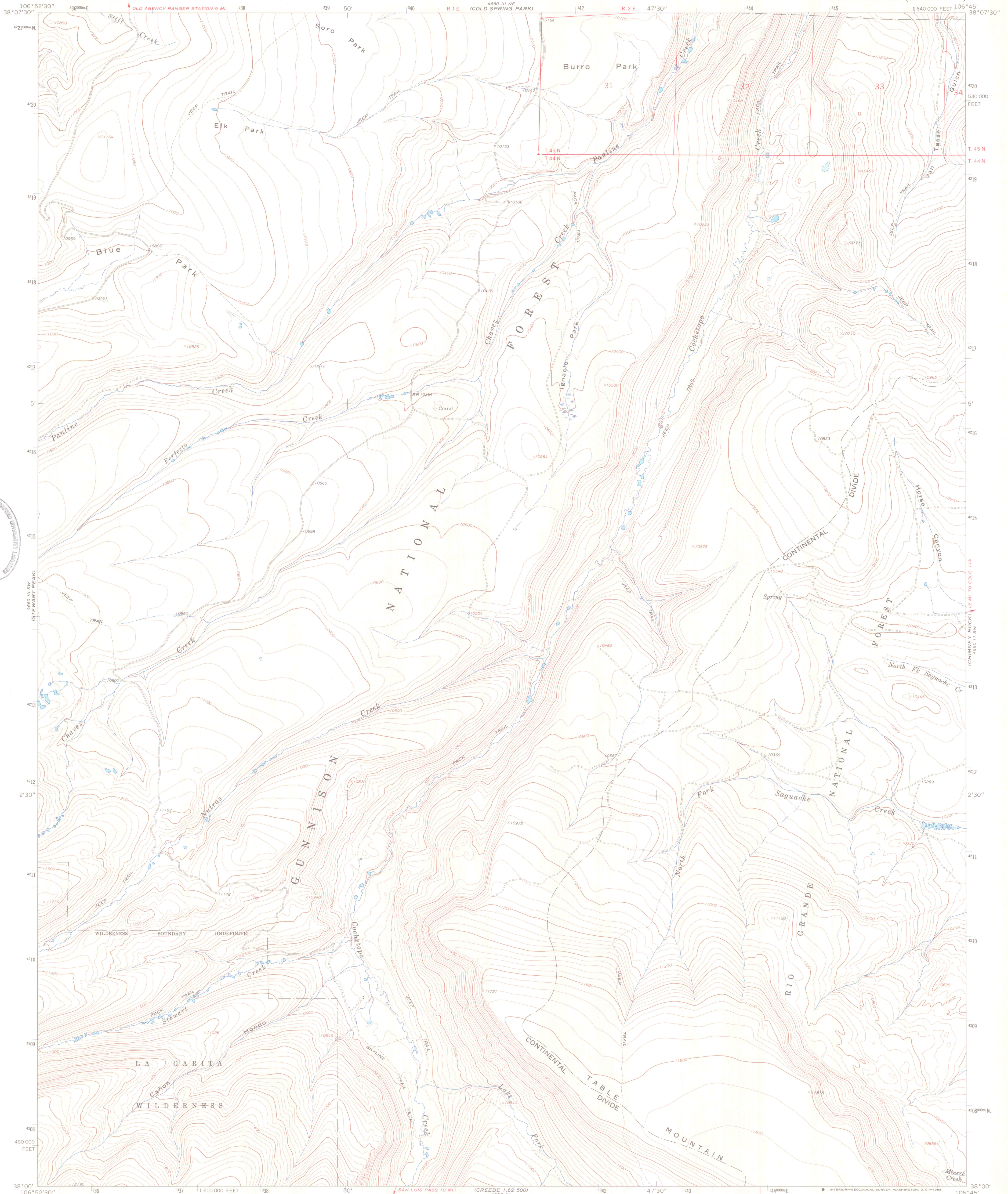

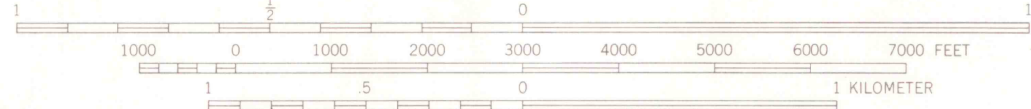
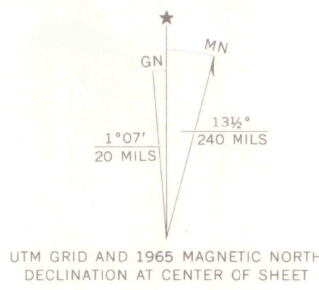
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines

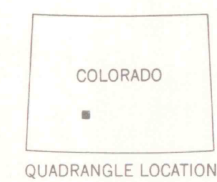
