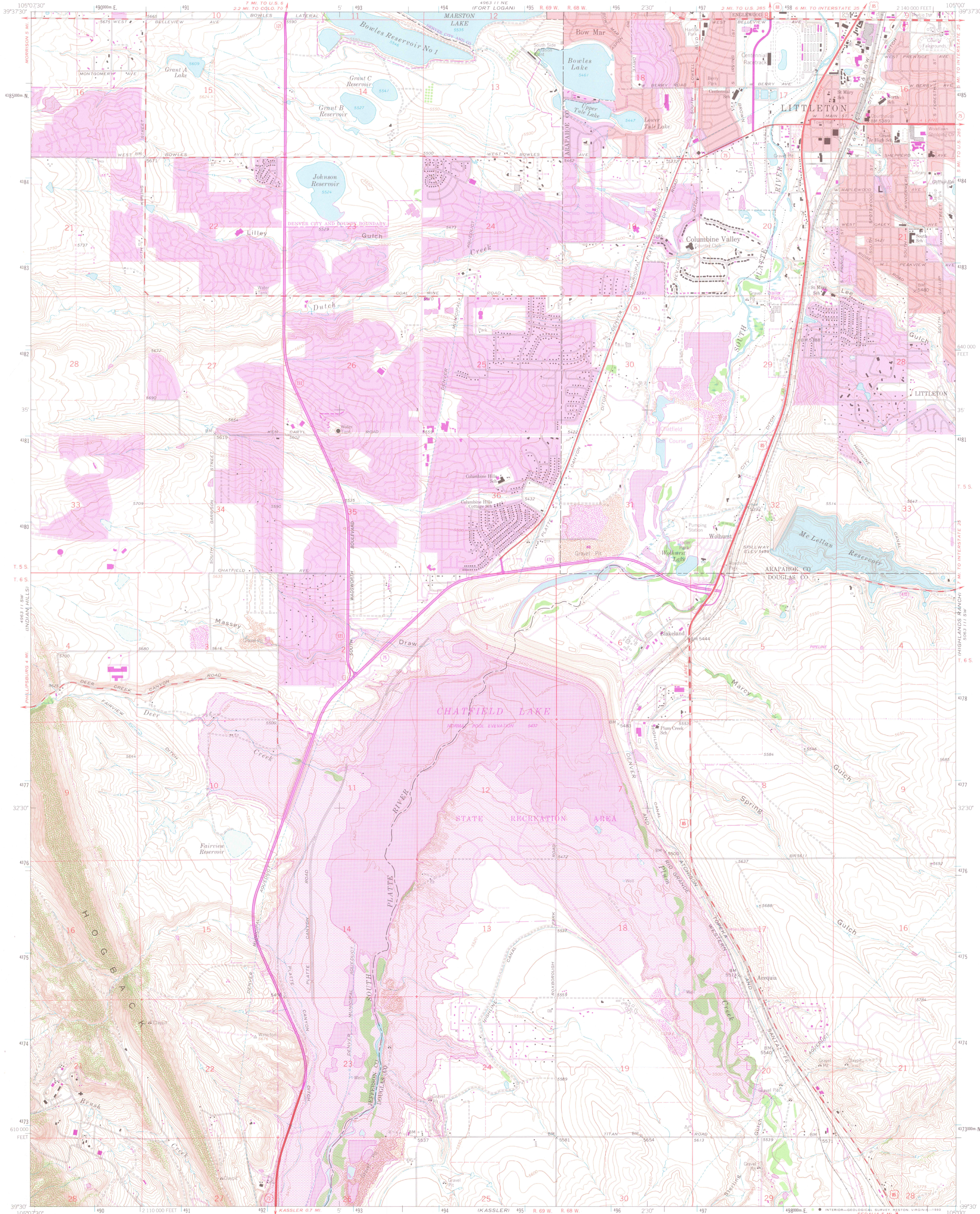

10,000-foot grid based on Colorado coordinate system, central zone 13, shown in blue

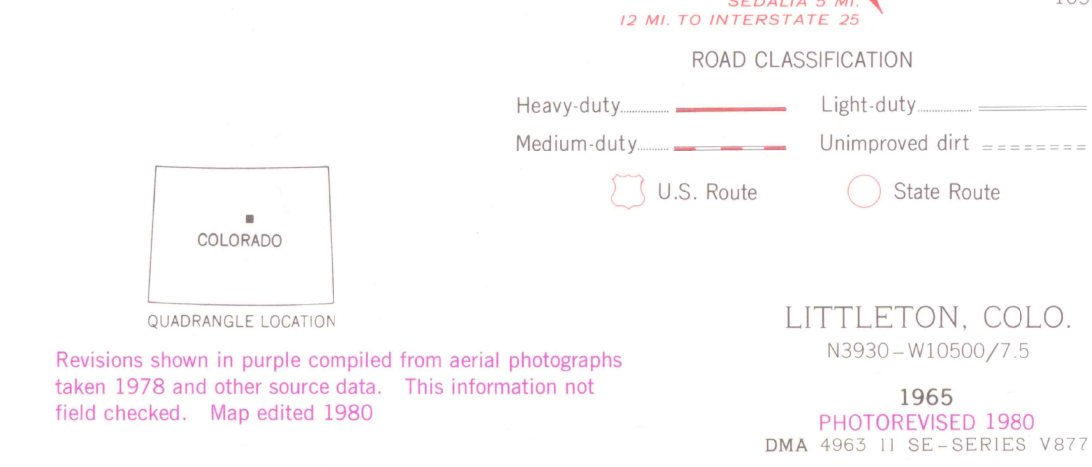
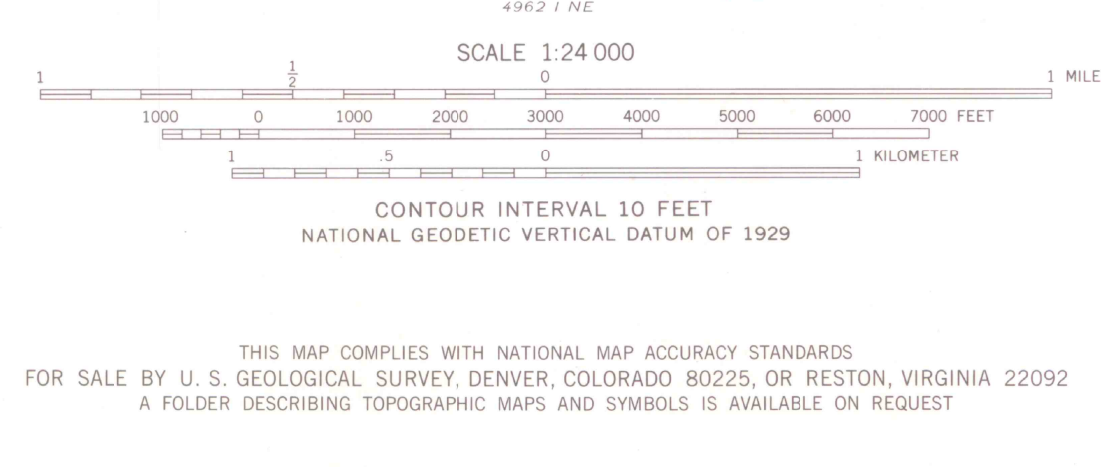
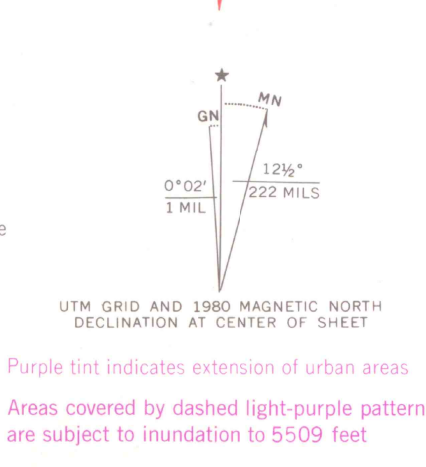
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 5 meters north and 48 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks



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
