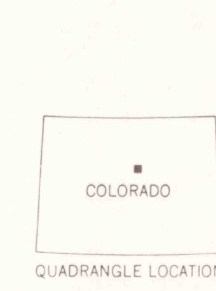
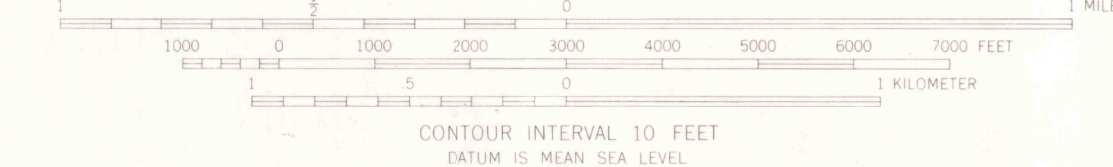
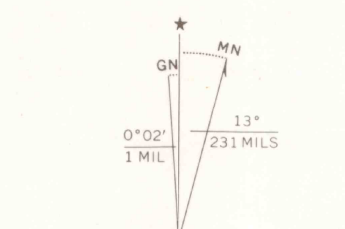
LITTLETON QUADRANGLE

Purple hatching indicates to be submerged by Chatfield Lake
at elevation 5426. Areas covered by dashed light purple pattern
are subject to controlled inundation to 5500 feet.
