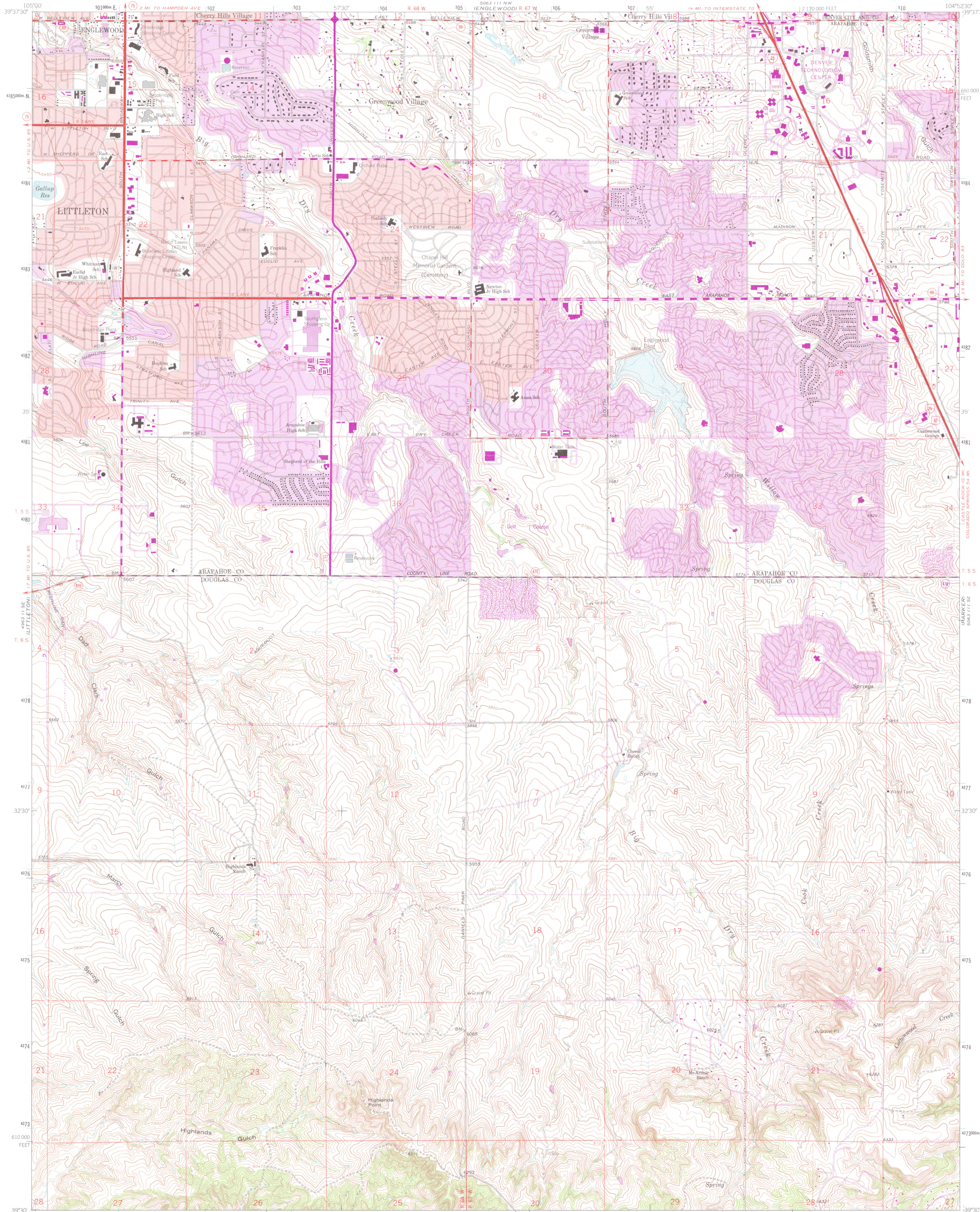

Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to controlled inundation

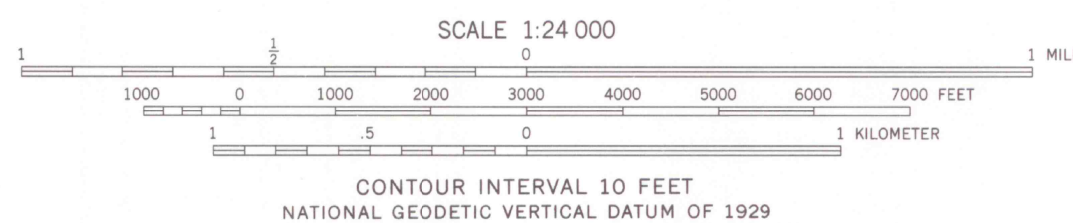
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines
