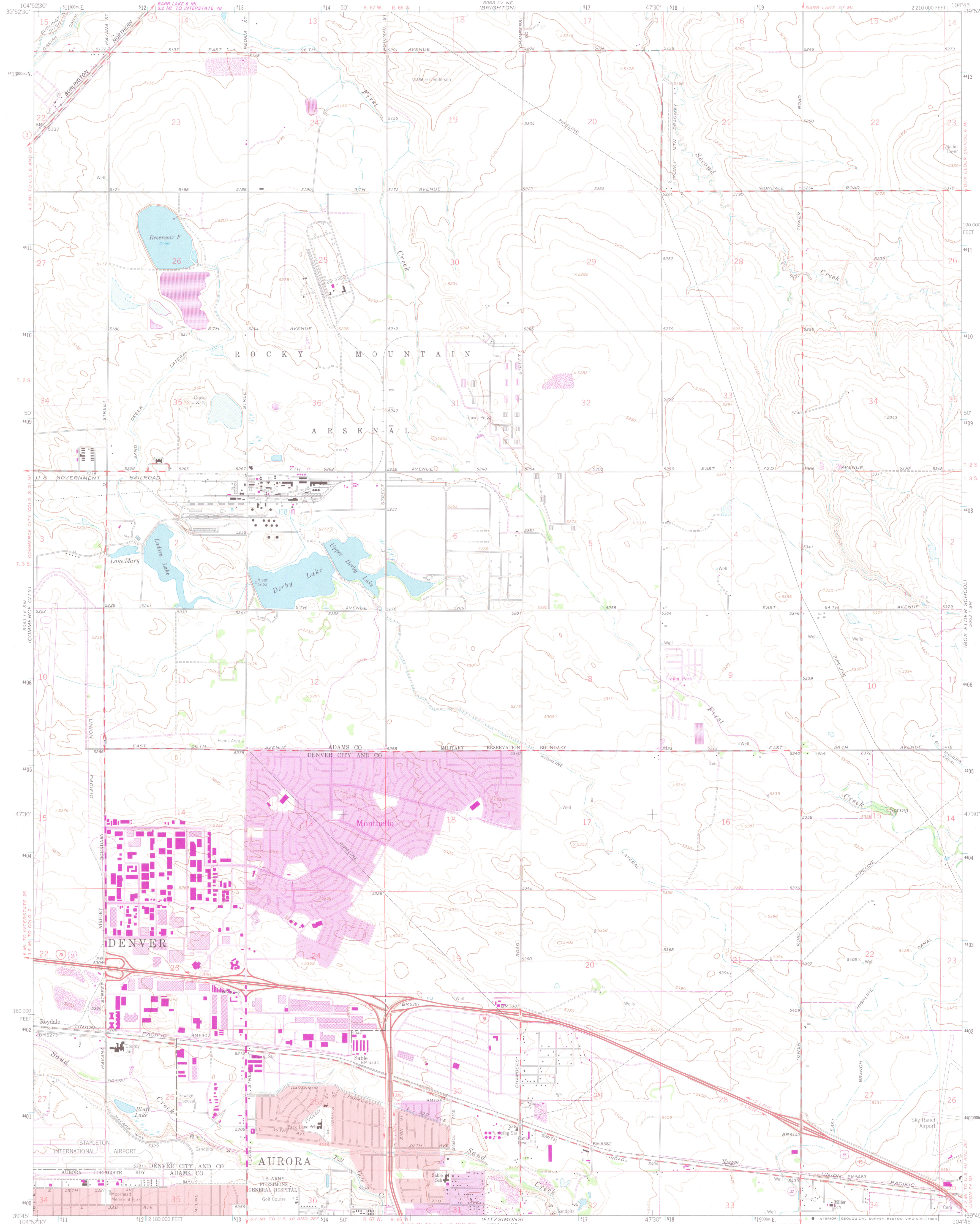

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines.

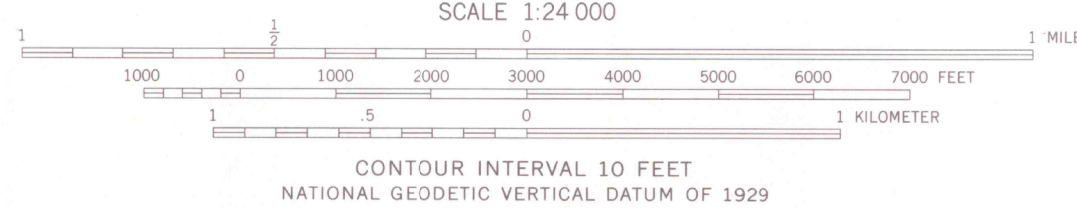
