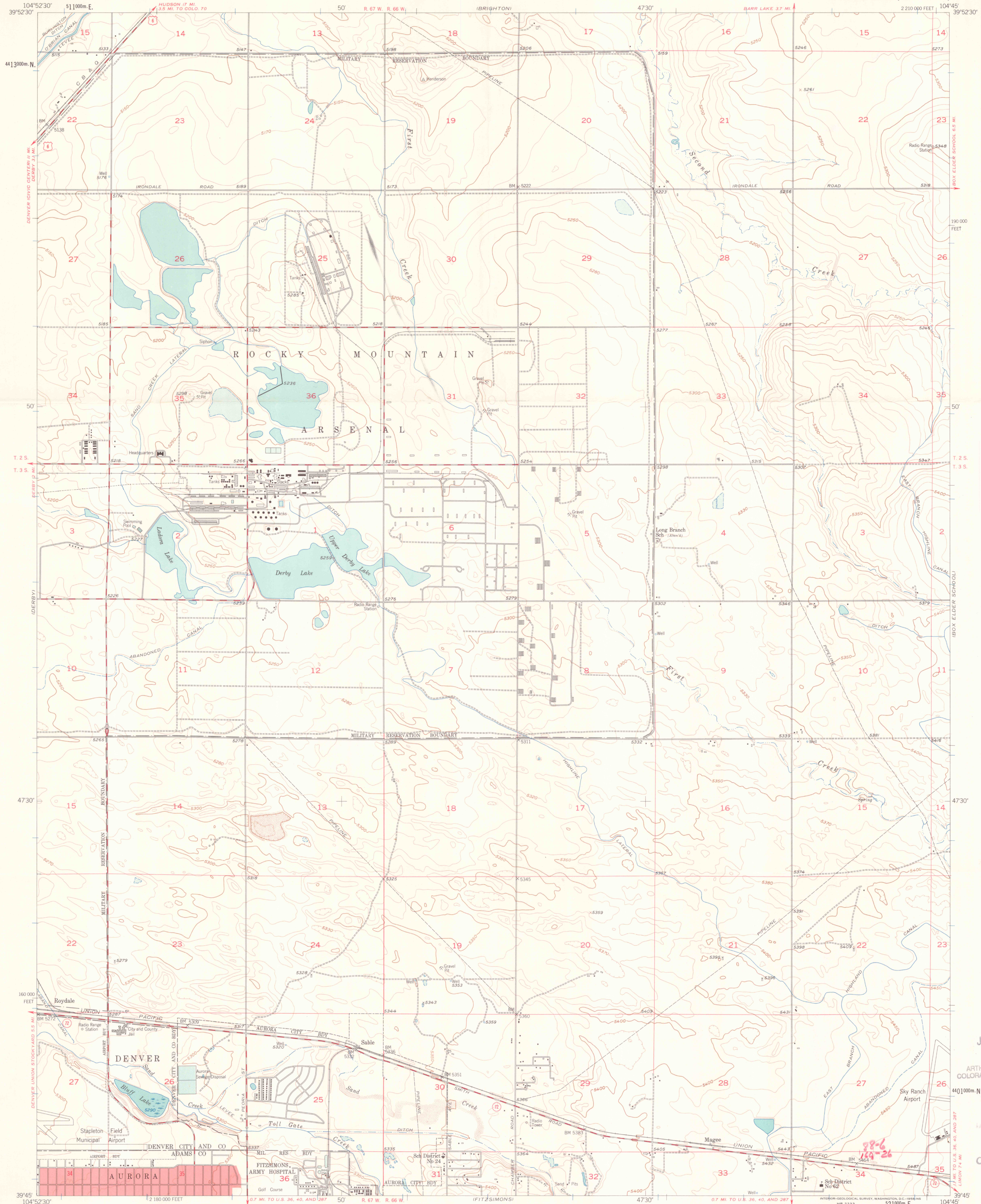

10,000-foot grid based on Colorado coordinate system,

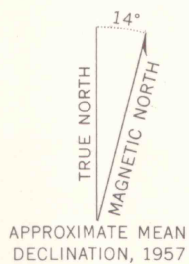
north zone

zone 13, shown in blue

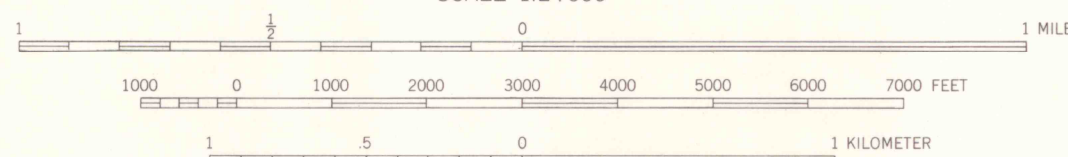
Red tint indicates areas in which only

landmark buildings are shown



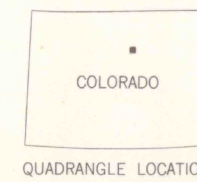
APPROXIMATE MEAN
