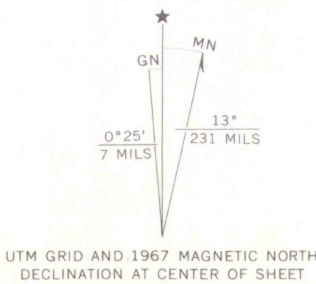

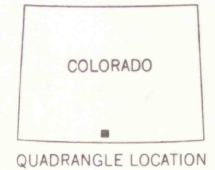
MESITO RESERVOIR QUADRANGLE
