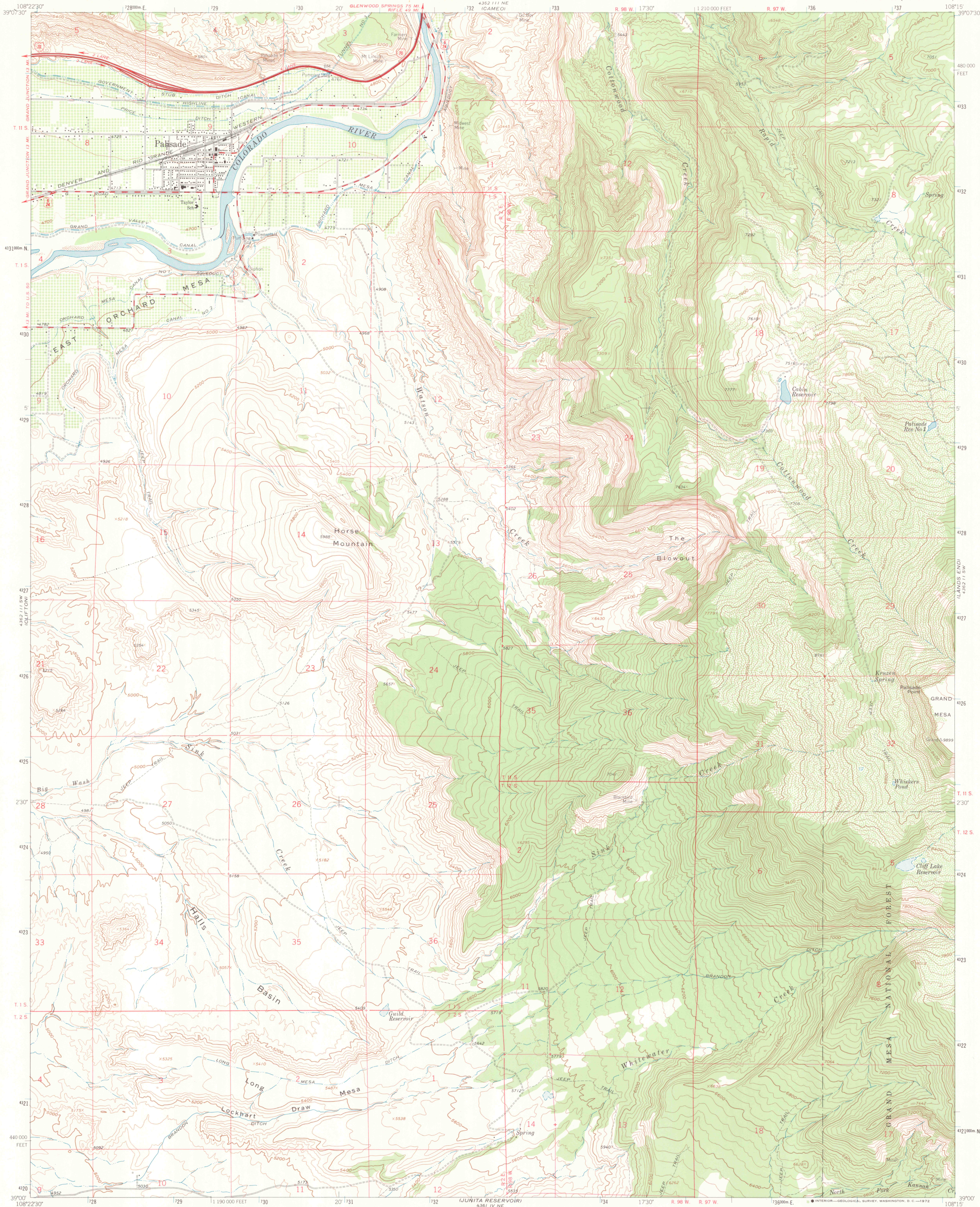

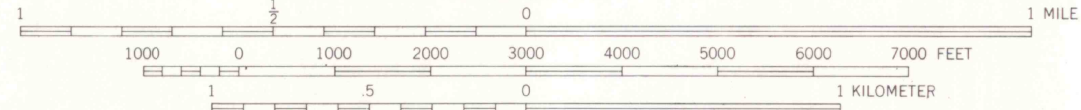
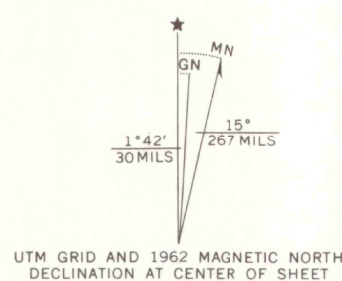

10,000-foot grid based on Colorado coordinate system, central zone

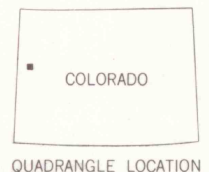
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 12, shown in blue
