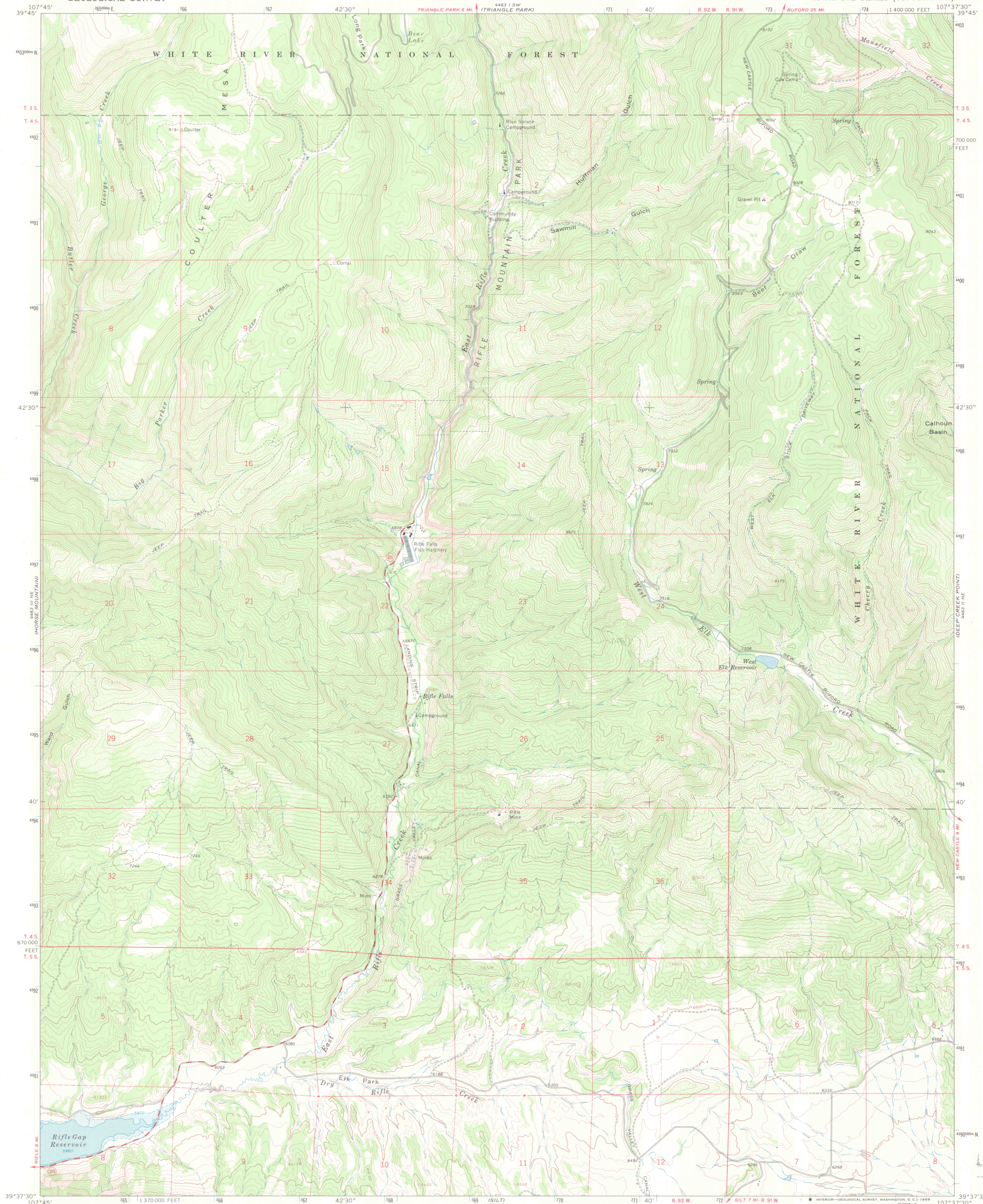

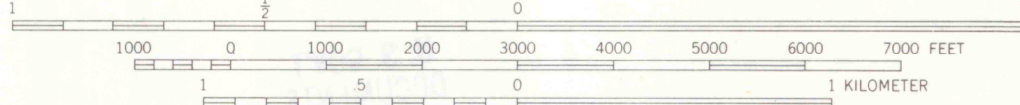
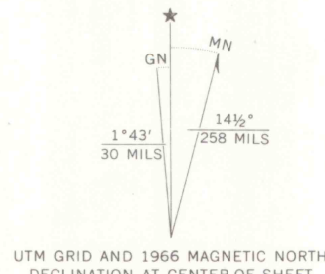
10,000-foot grid based on Colorado coordinate system, central zone

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines

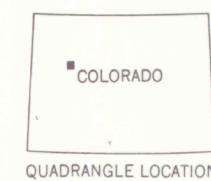
