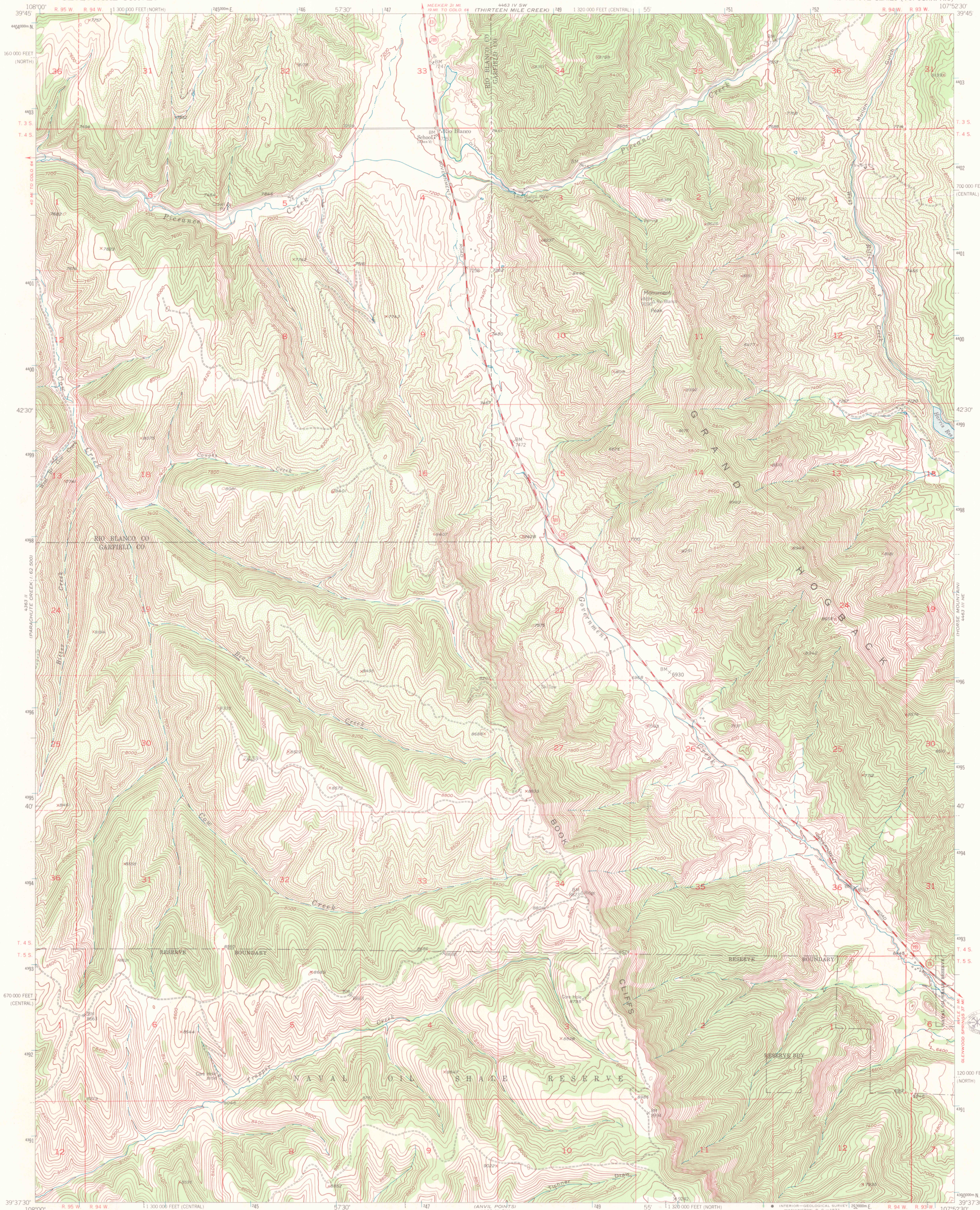

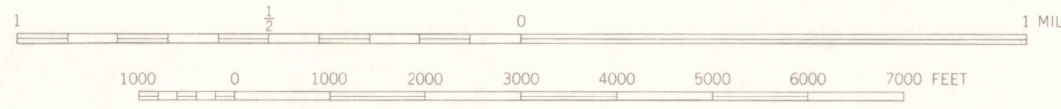
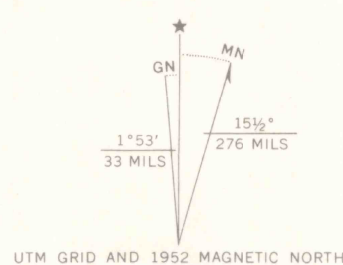

central and north zones

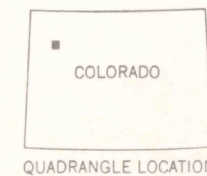
Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations
