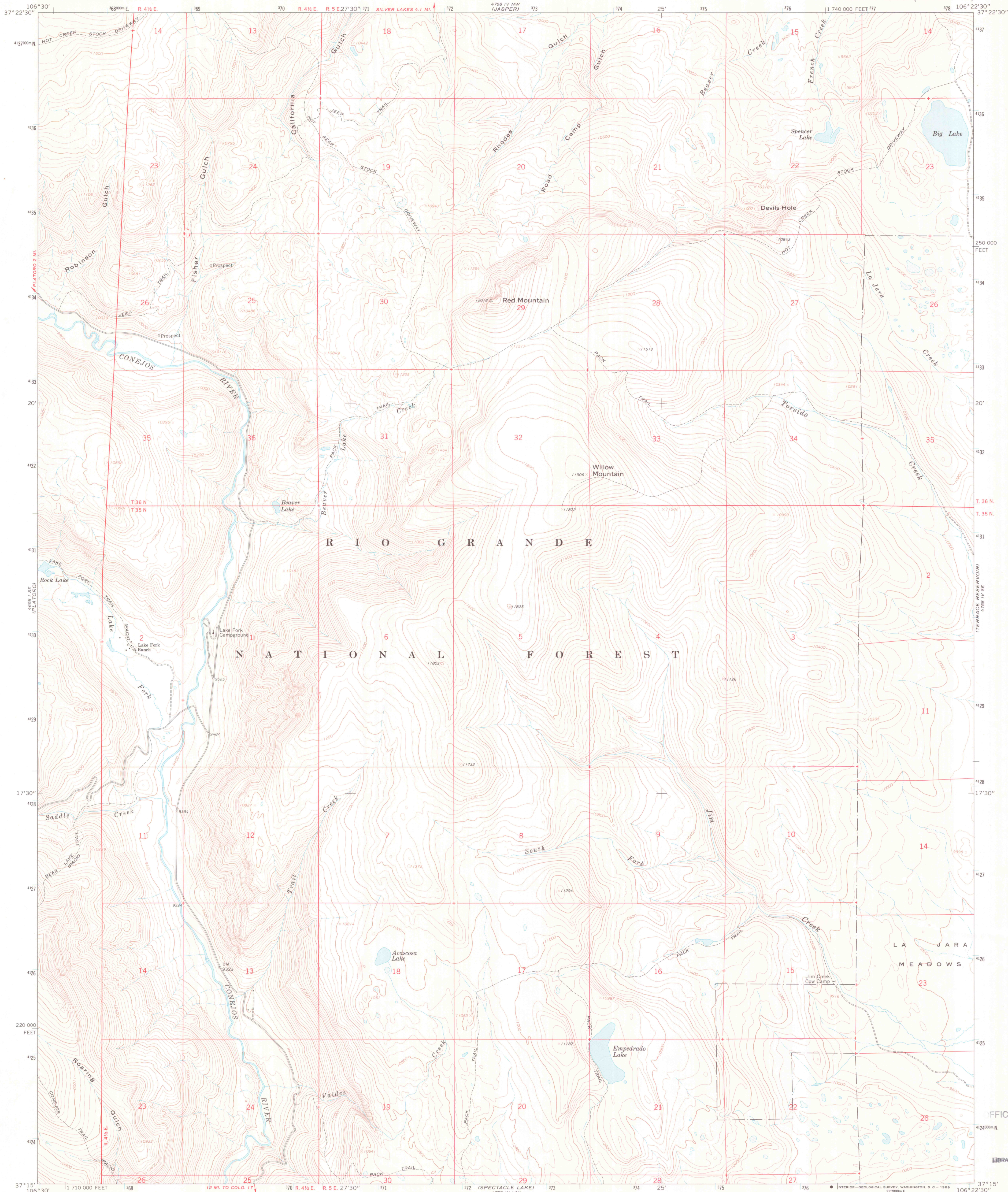

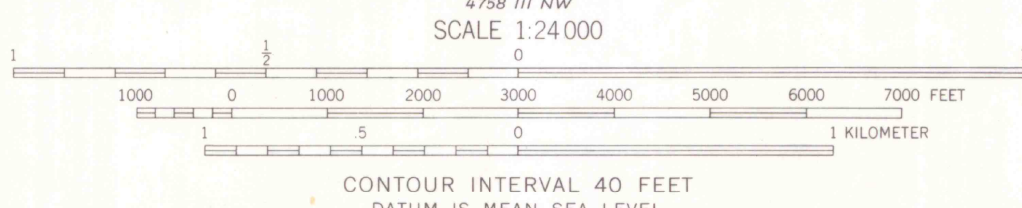
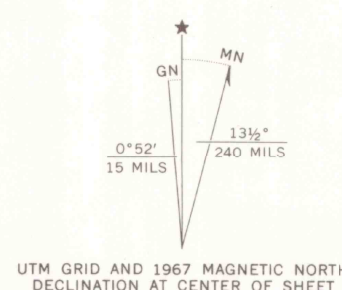
RED MOUNTAIN QUADRANGLE

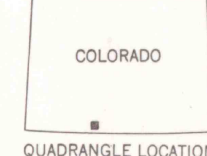
