

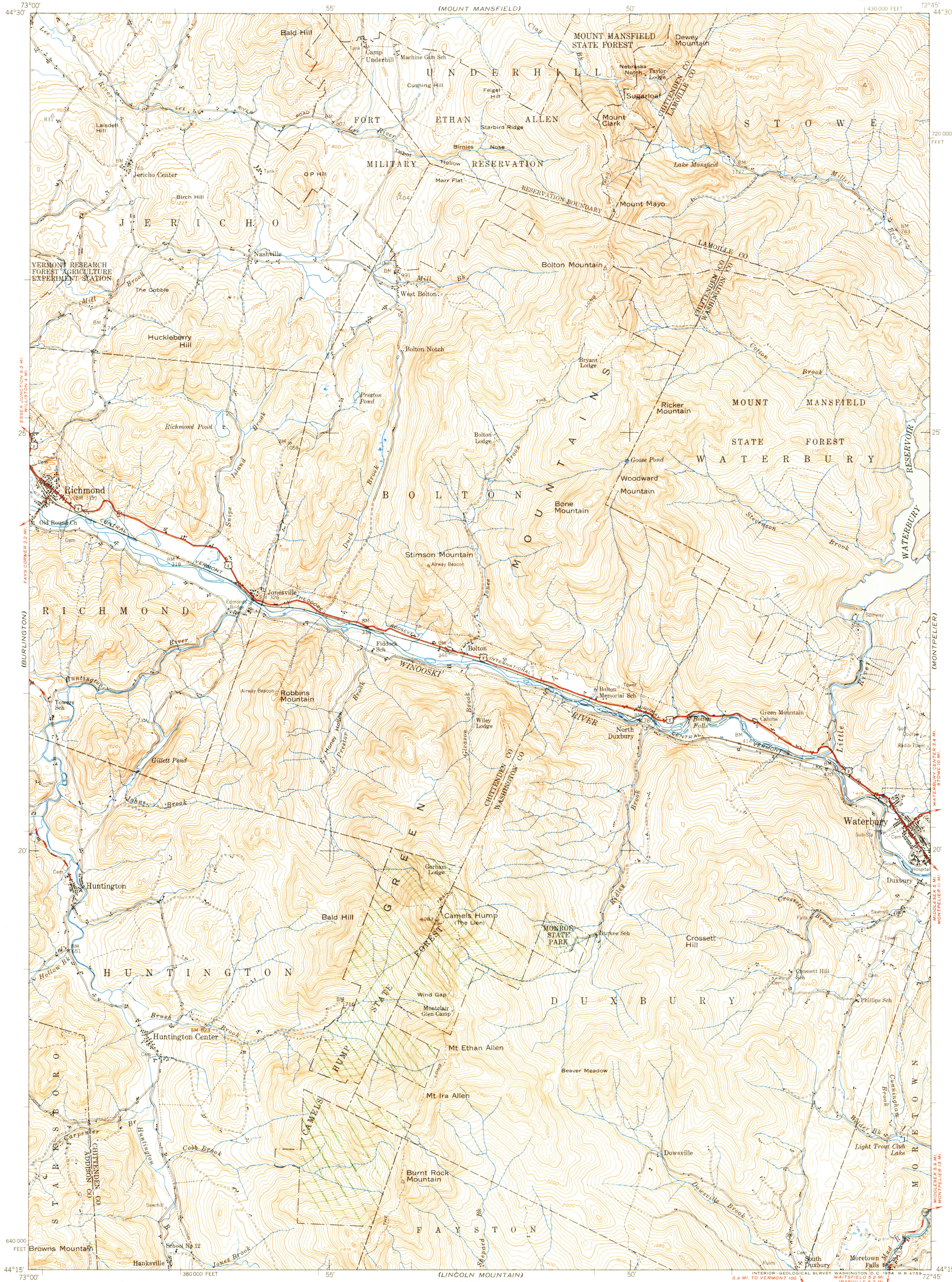

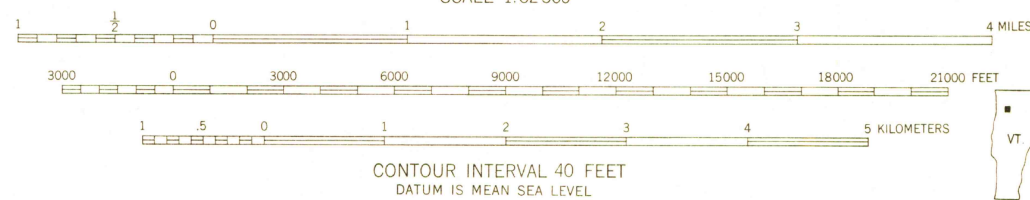
CAMELS HUMP QUADRANGLE
