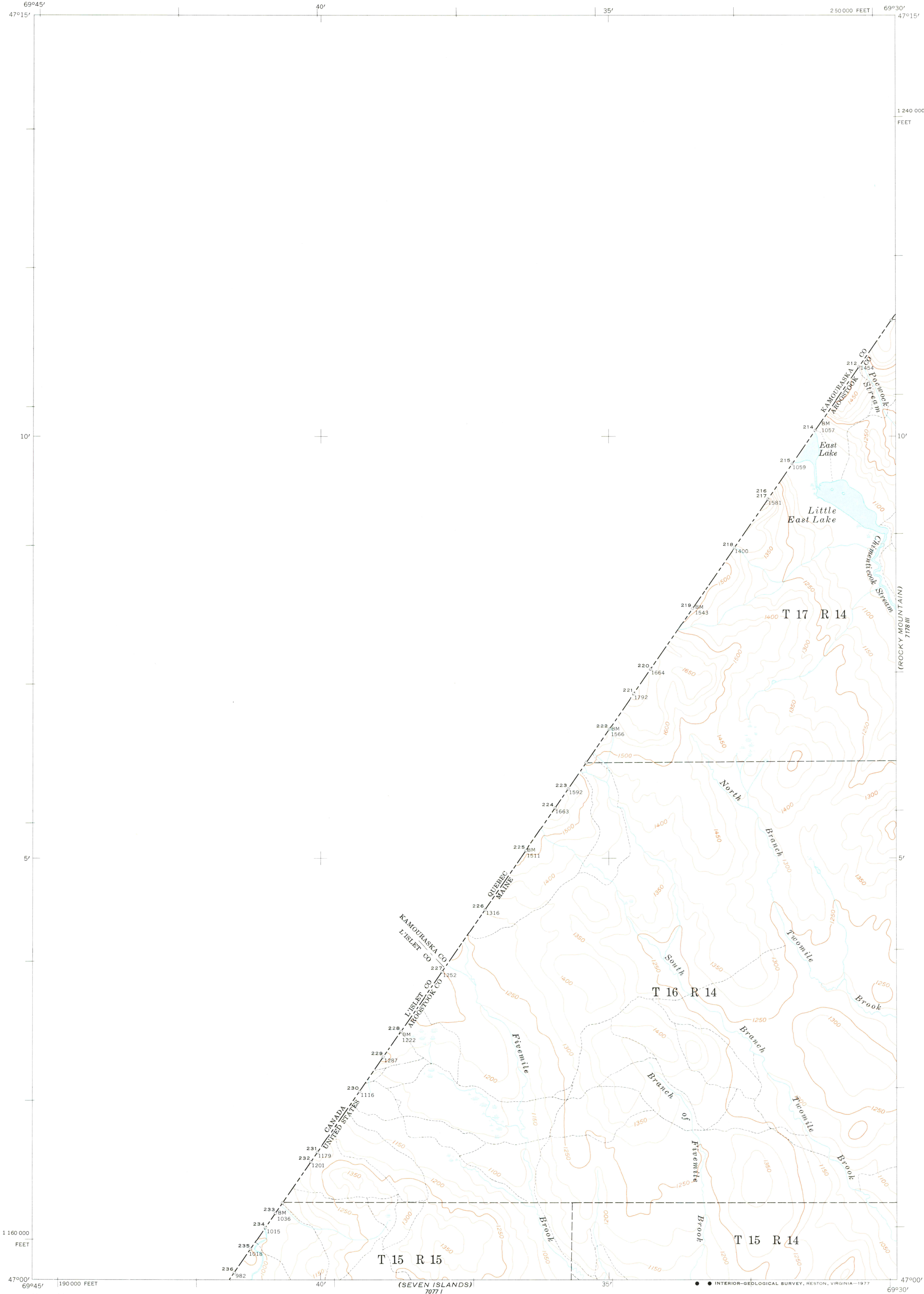


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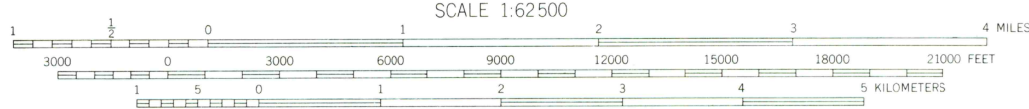
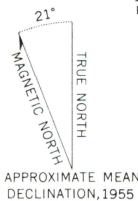
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10,000-foot grid based on Maine coordinate system,
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
