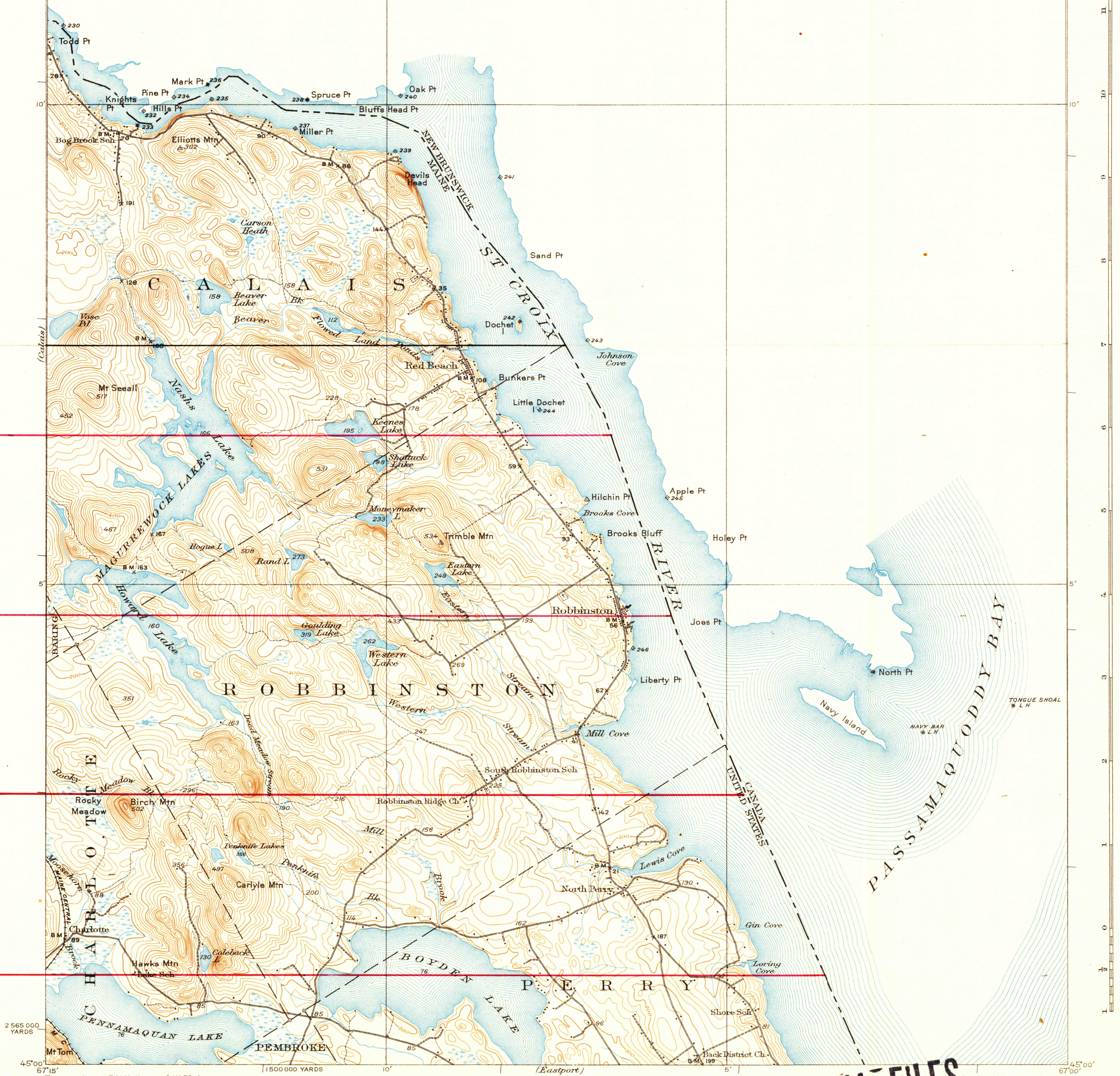


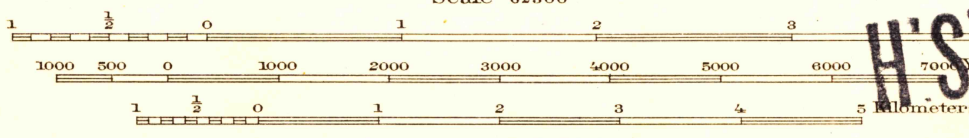
FLIGHT HEIGHT = 11,800 FEET ABOVE MEAN TERRAIN
