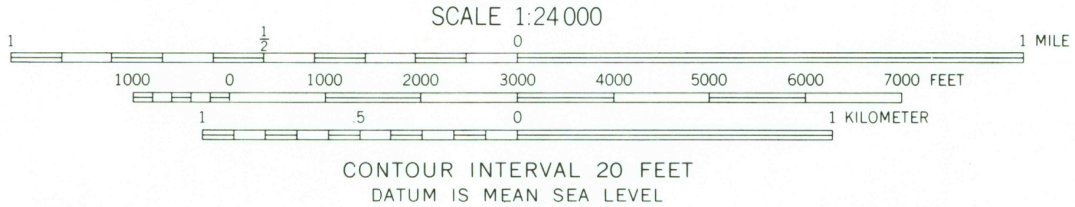
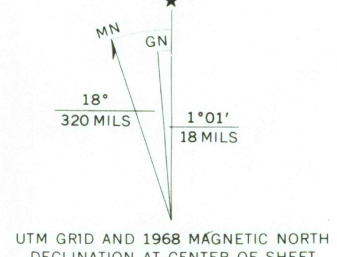


PHILLIPS 1:62 500'
