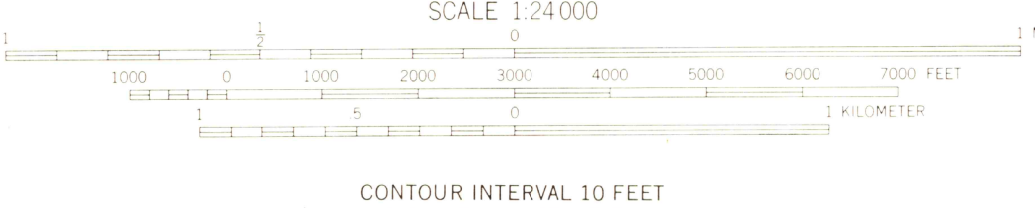
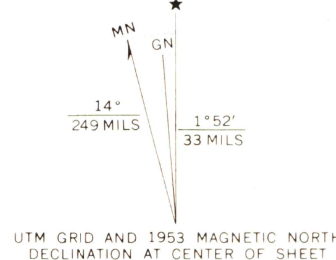




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Topography by plane-table surveys 1942-1943. Revised 1953
