

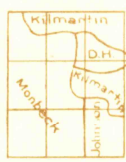

EAGLES MERE QUADRANGLE



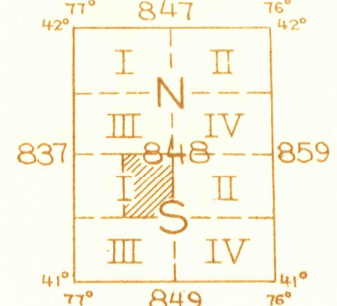
