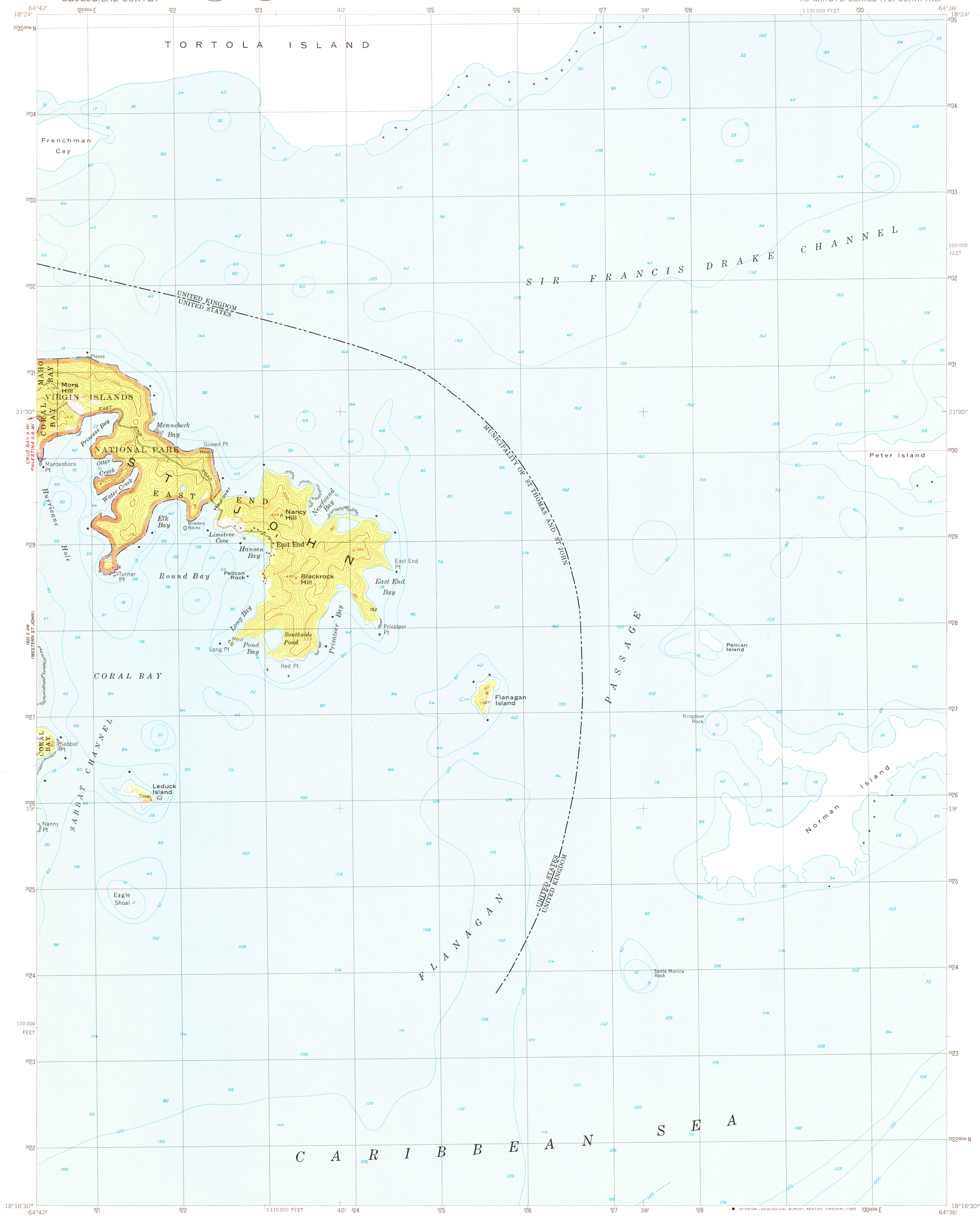
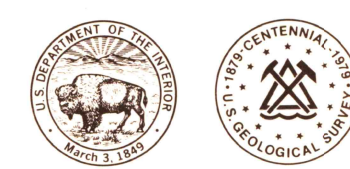

10,000-foot grid based on Puerto Rican coordinate system,

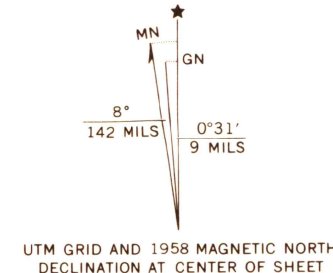
Virgin Islands extension
