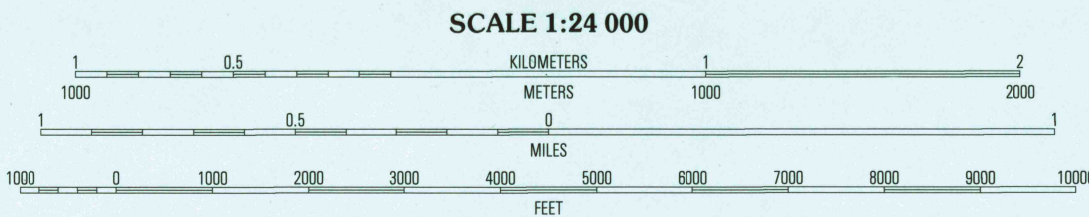




TOPOGRAPHIC MAP

THE MEAN RANGE OF TIDE IS APPROXIMATELY 3 FEET
TO CONVERT FROM FEET TO METERS, MULTIPLY BY 0.3048

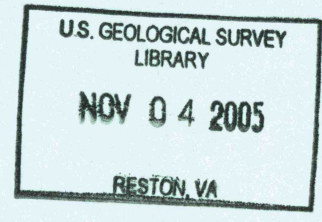
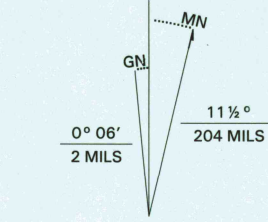
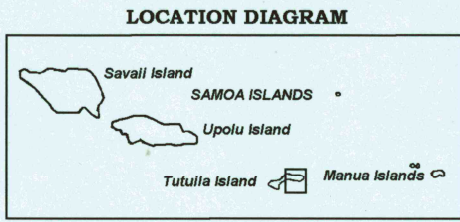
