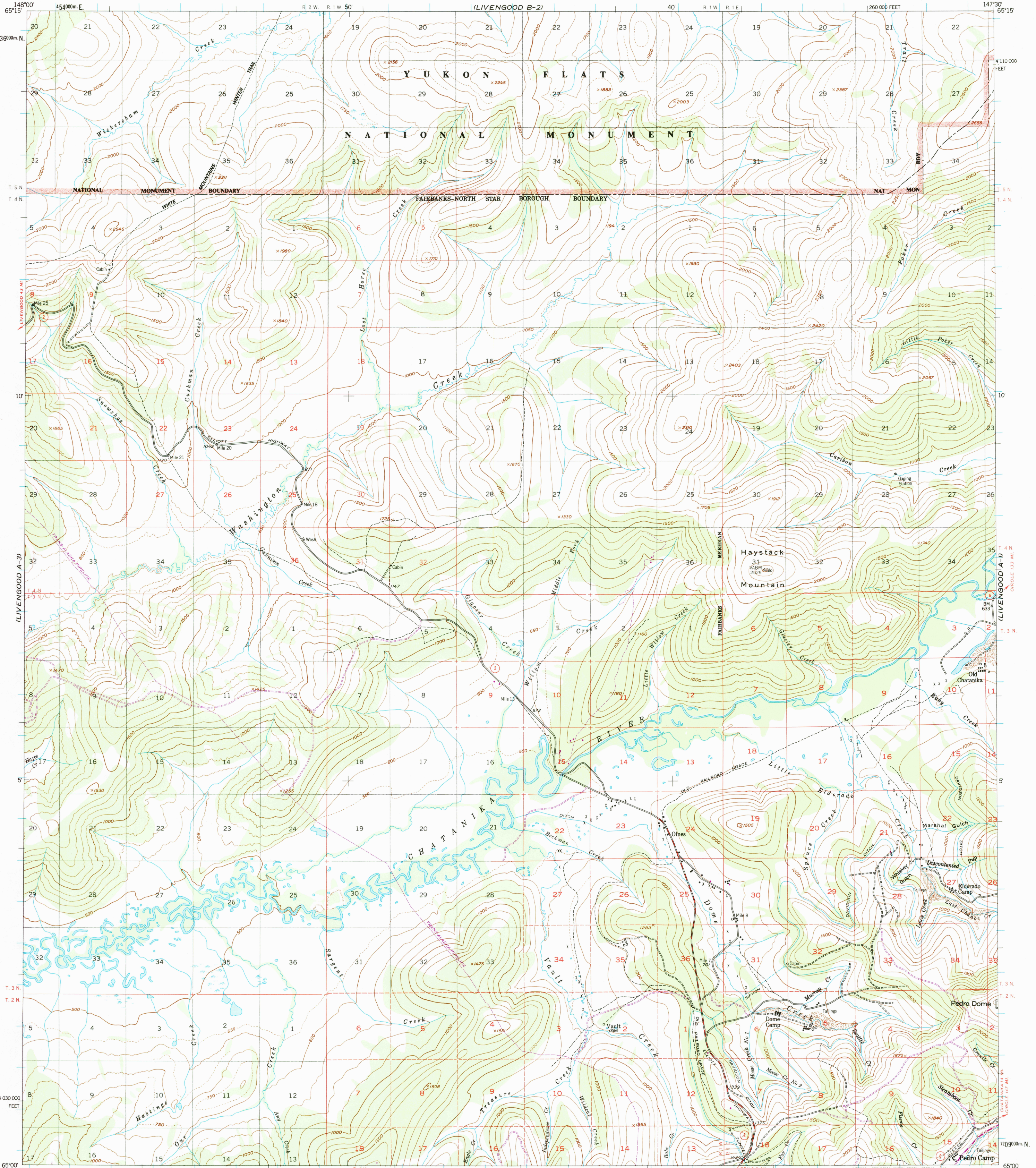

is given in USGS Bulletin 1875

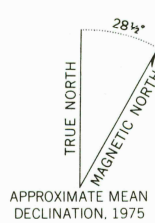

shown as compiled by the administering agencies

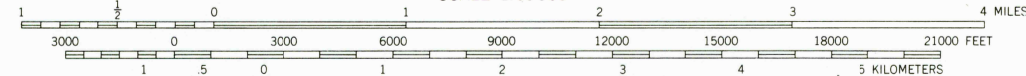
