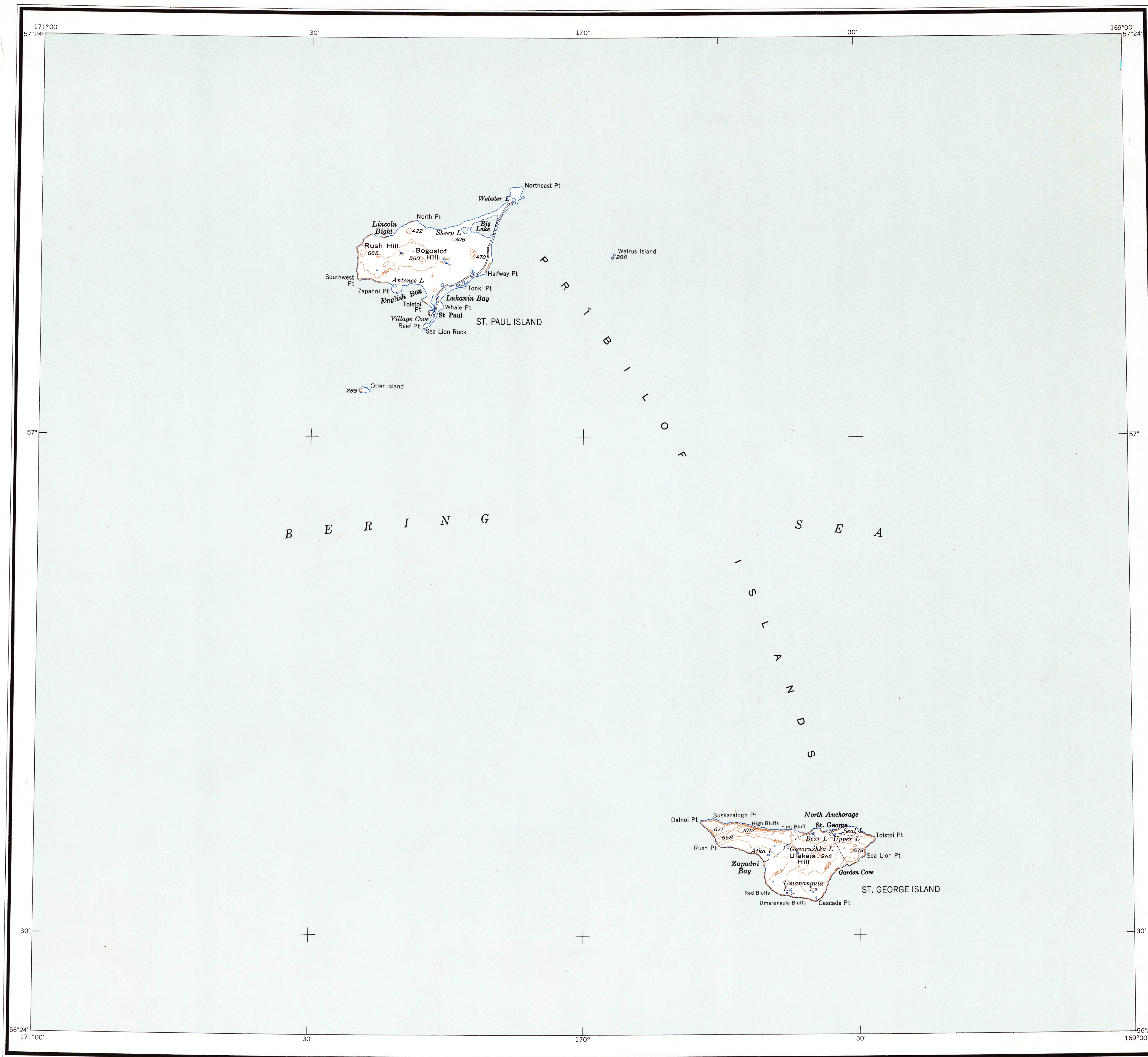
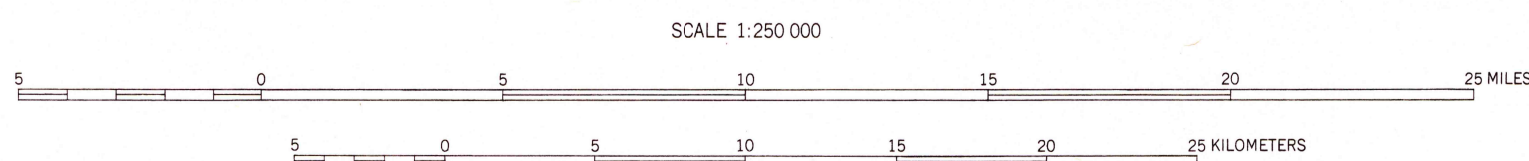
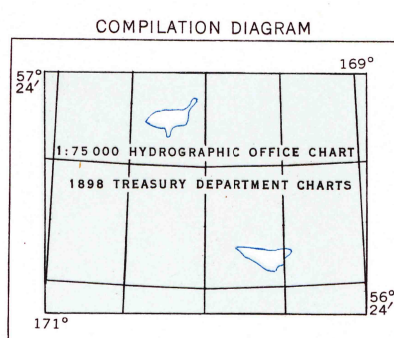

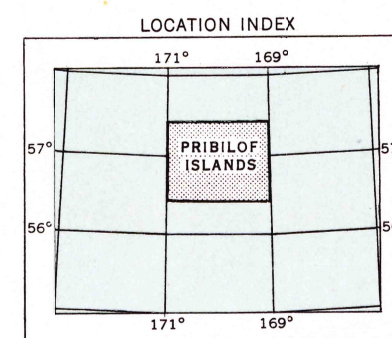


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OFFICE CHART AND 1898 TREASURY DEPARTMENT CHARTS  
POLYCONIC PROJECTION. ST. PAUL-ST. GEORGE 1944 DATUM



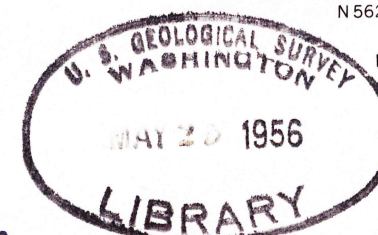
CONTOUR INTERVAL 200 FEET
