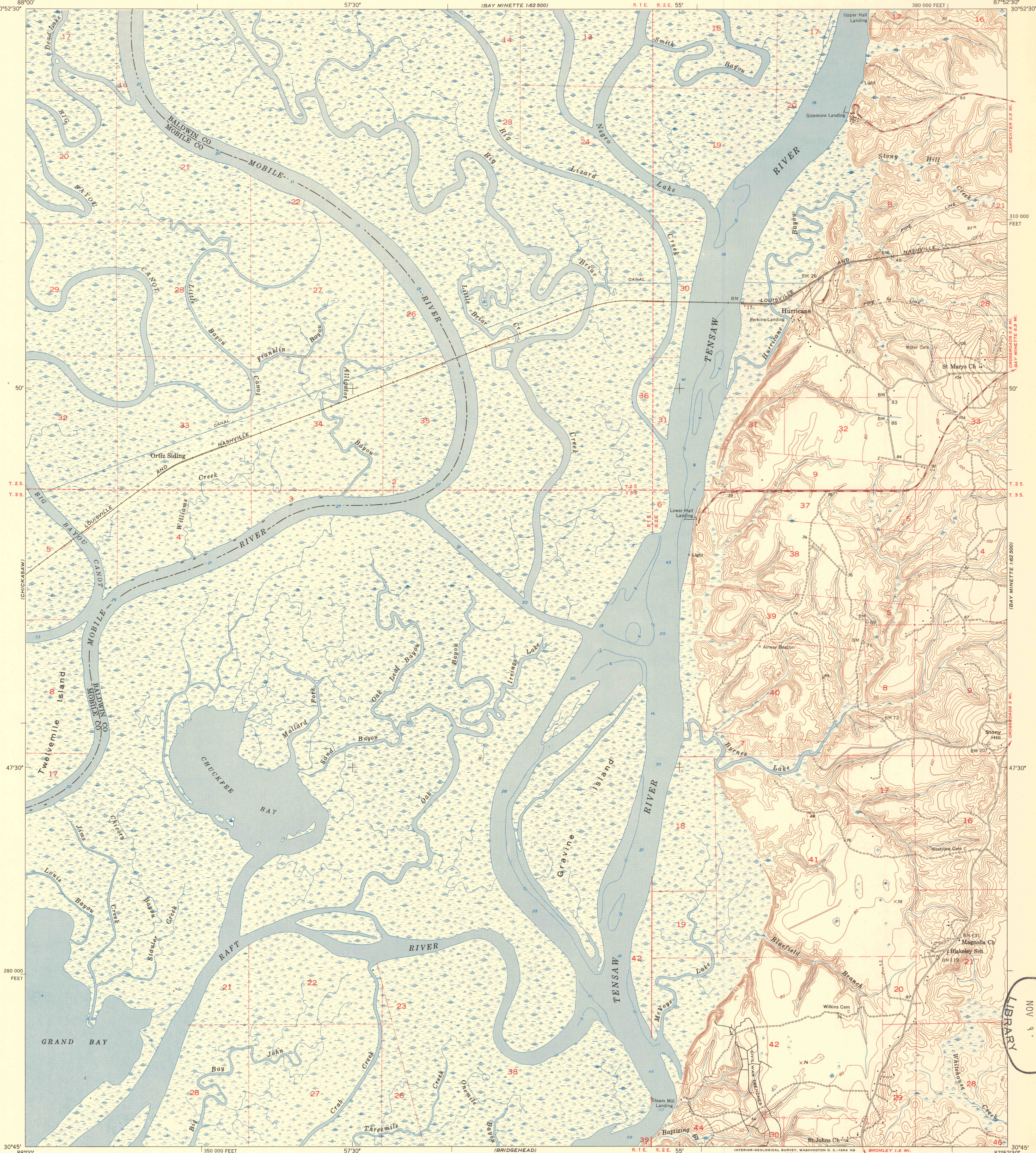

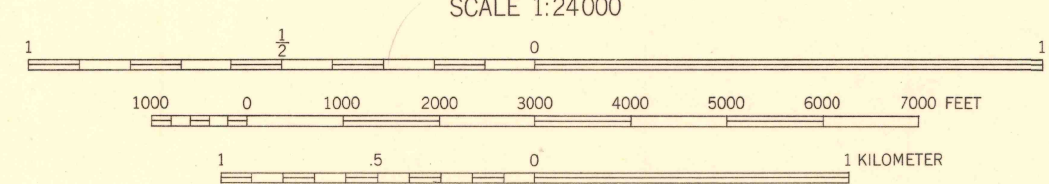
HURRICANE QUADRANGLE

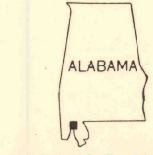
