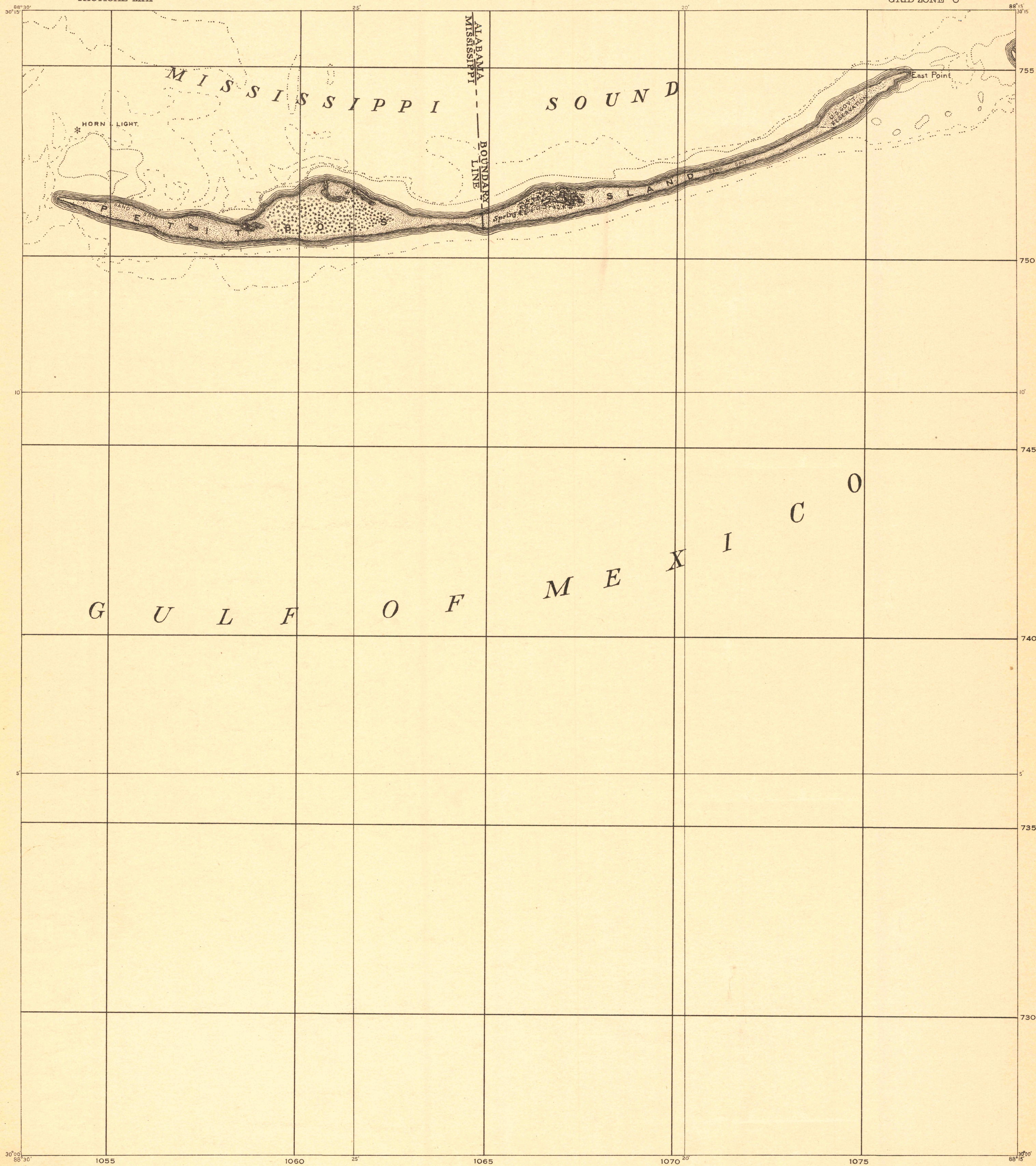


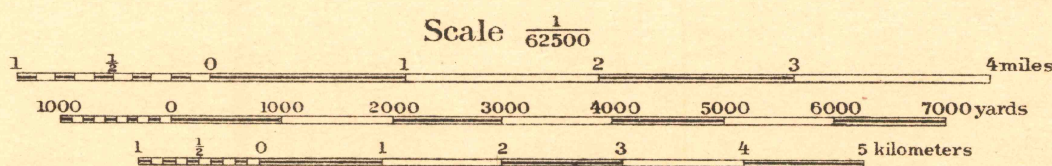
CORPS OF ENGINEERS, U. S. ARMY

GRID ZONE "C"

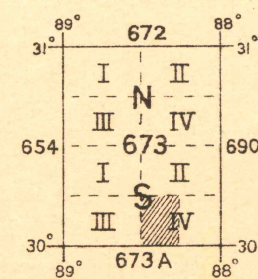
