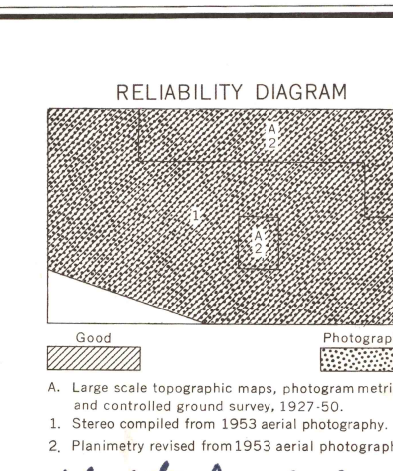
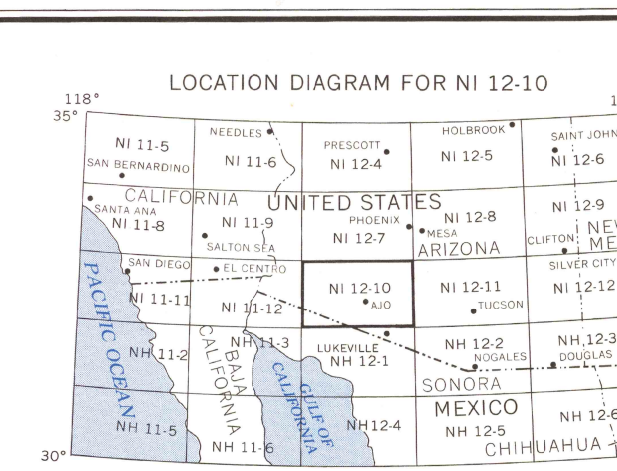
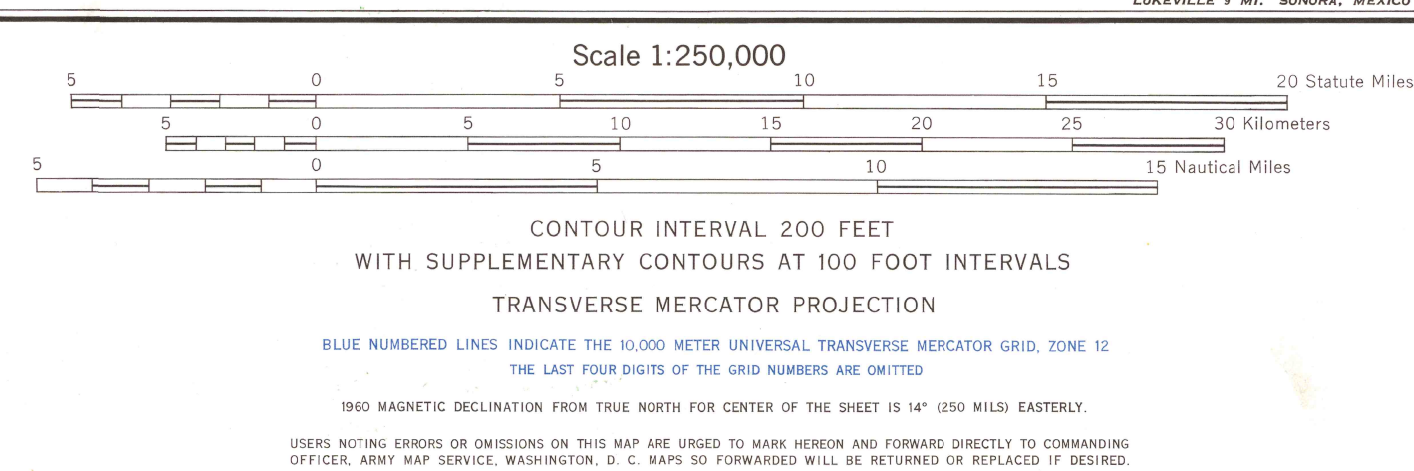

TO VIEW A STANDARD REFERENCE, SEE THIS SHEET TO LOCATE 100 METERS

SAMPLE POINT: ROWWOOD

1. Read title, identifying 1000 meters square in which the point lies.
2. Locate first VERTICAL and grid line to LEFT of point.
3. Locate first HORIZONTAL and grid line to LEFT of point or the top or bottom margin, or on the line itself.
4. Estimate fourths then grid line to point:
 - a. 1000 feet HORIZONTAL, and grid below point and read LARGE figure labeling the line on the left from 100 to 900, or on the line itself.
 - b. 1000 feet VERTICAL, and grid to the left of point and read LARGE figure labeling the line on the top from 100 to 900, or on the line itself.

SAMPLE REFERENCE: 10,7600

If representing beyond 10° in any direction, prefix Grid Zone Designation, as: 12S,7600
