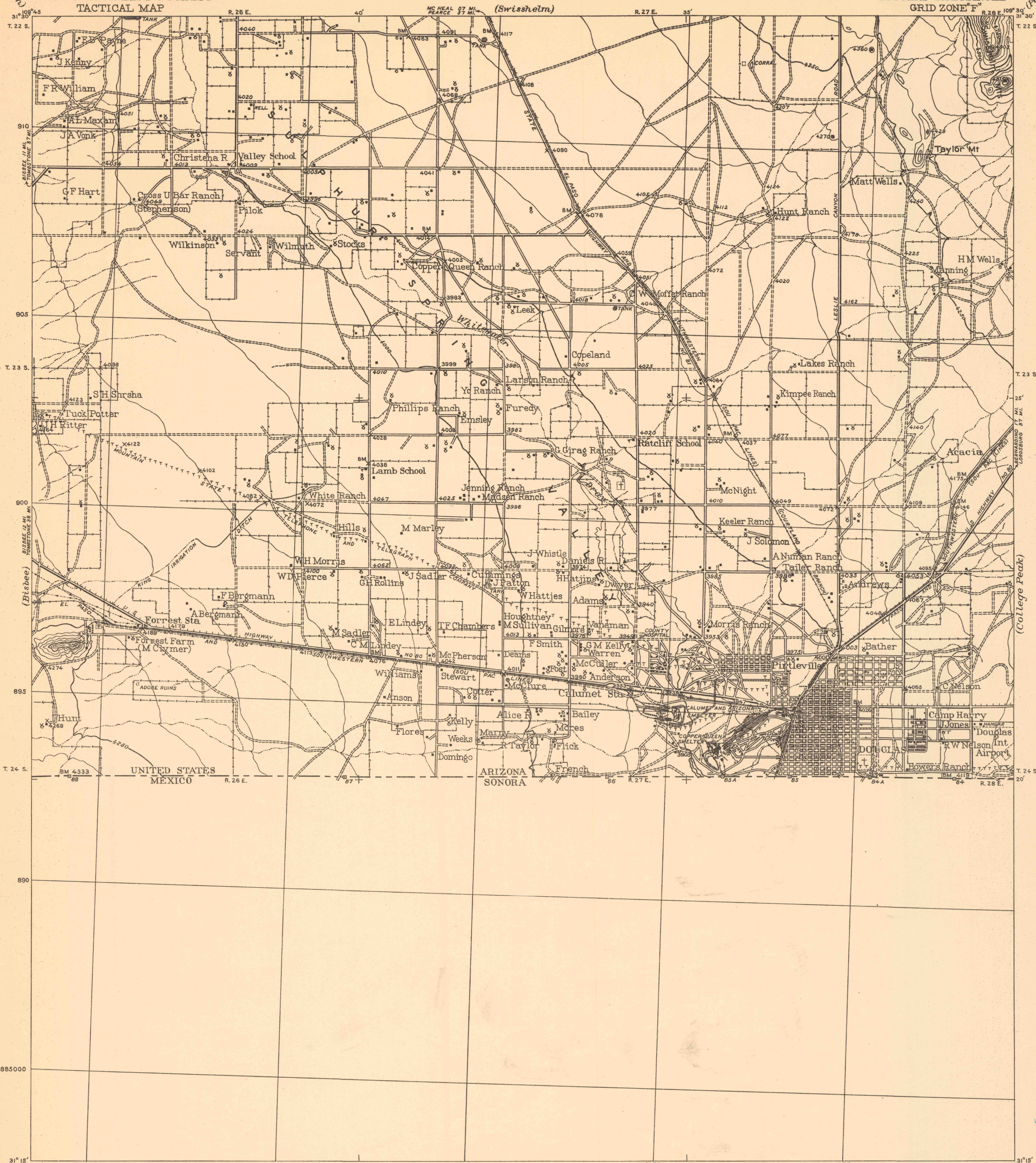

TACTICAL MAP



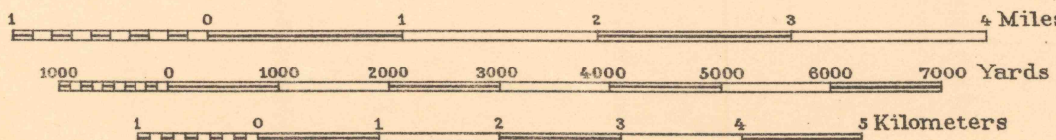

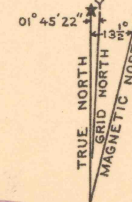
