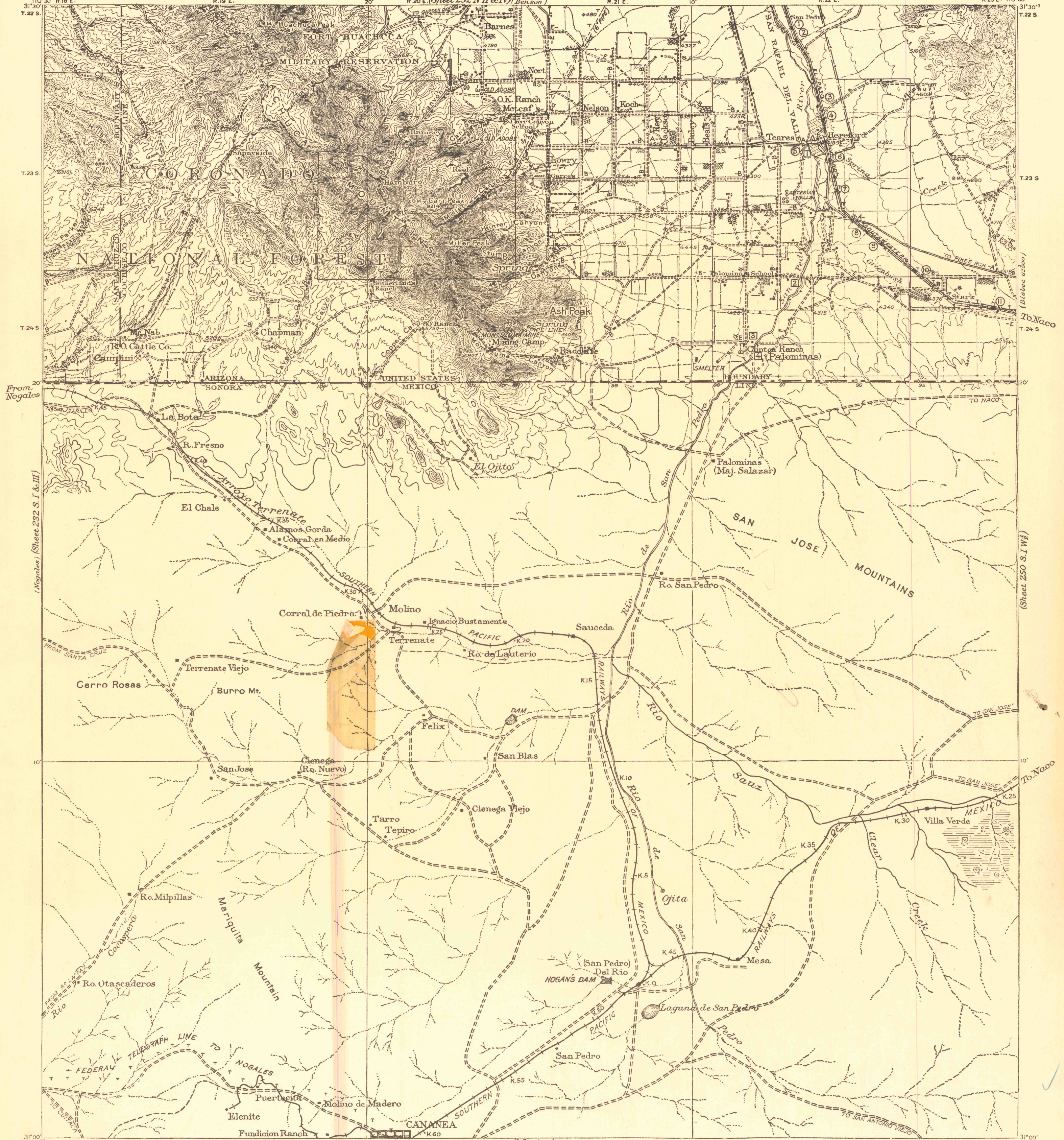


PROGRESSIVE MILITARY MAP OF THE UNITED STATES

Control on MEXICAN side is based on maps of International Boundary Commission,
alignment of Southern Pacific Railway Company of Mexico and surveys of ranch lands.

Telegraph and telephone lines for railroad service parallel the tracks, Naco to Nogales
and Cananea. A federal telegraph line between Naco and Cananea is strung on the railroad
company's poles. A private telephone line extends from Naco to Cananea but data as to its
location is not available at present.
