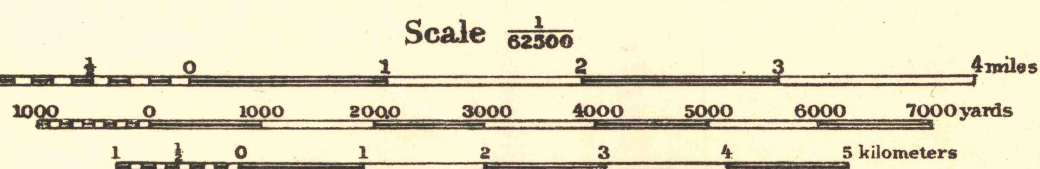

GRID ZONE "E" 15



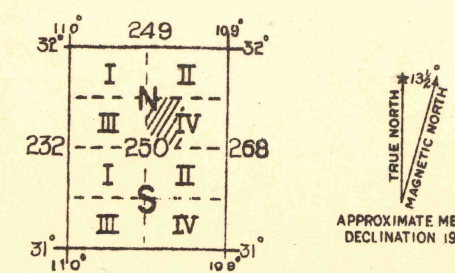
