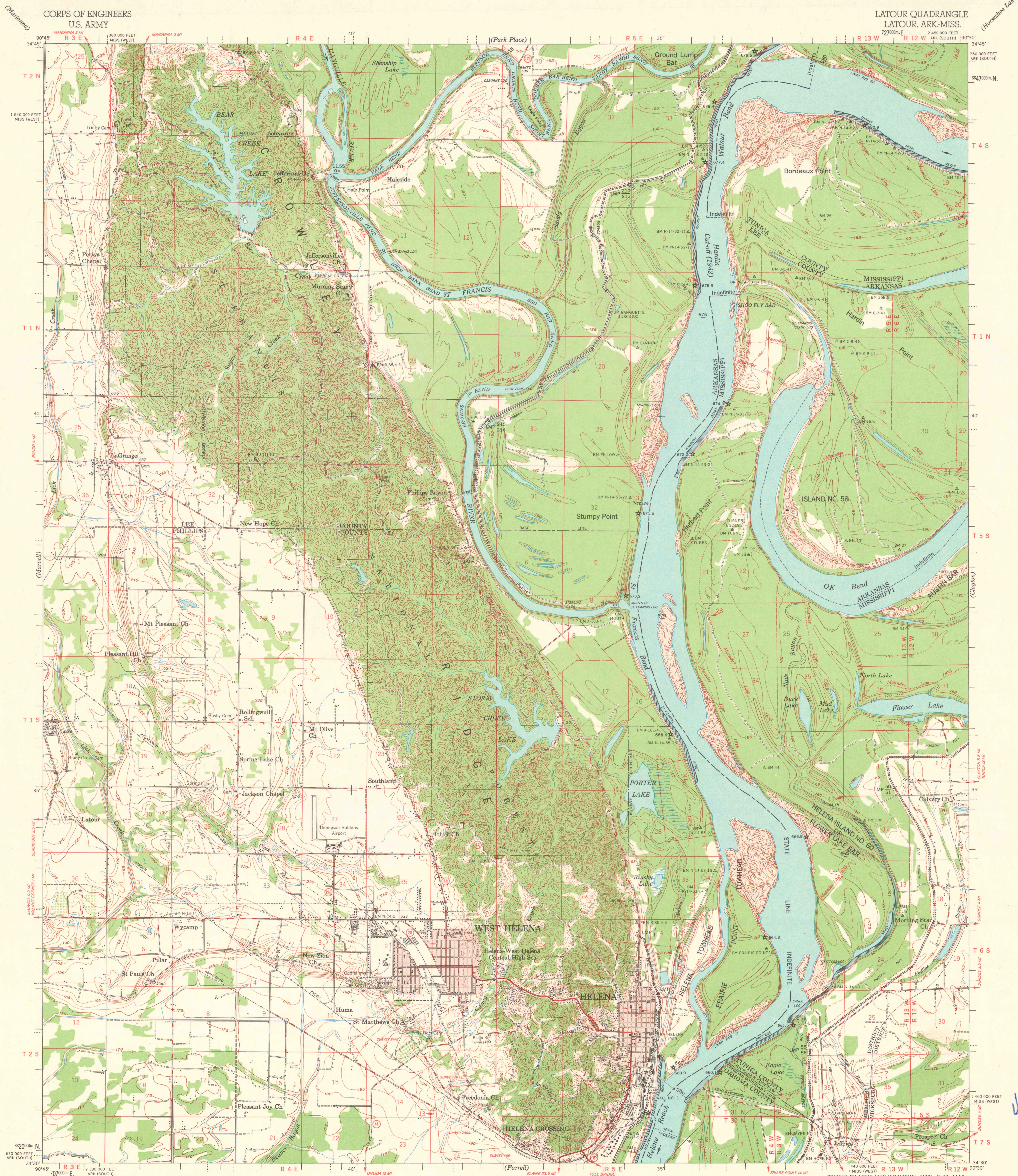
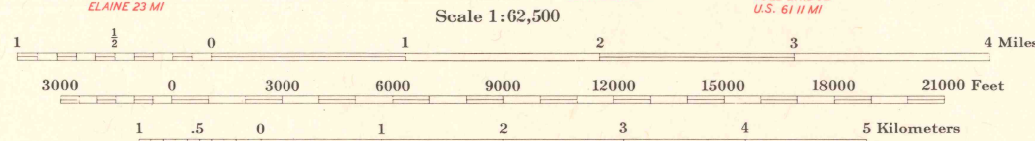




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Topography from aerial photographs by Kelsh plotter 1961 and from planetable surveys 1930-1949, 1961.
