

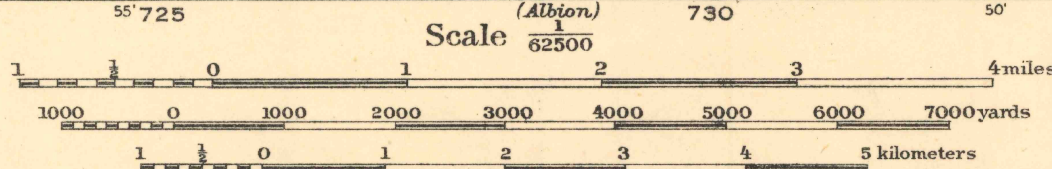

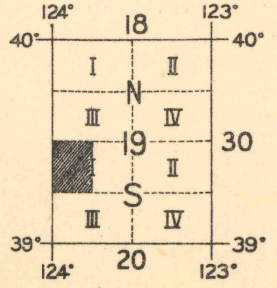


Contour Interval 100 feet
