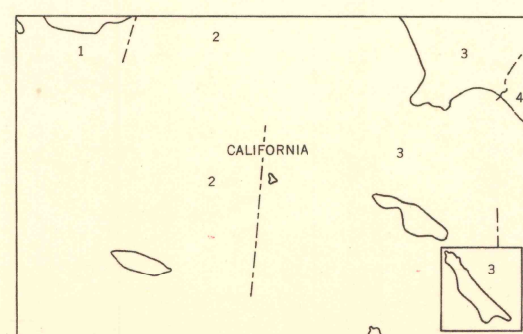

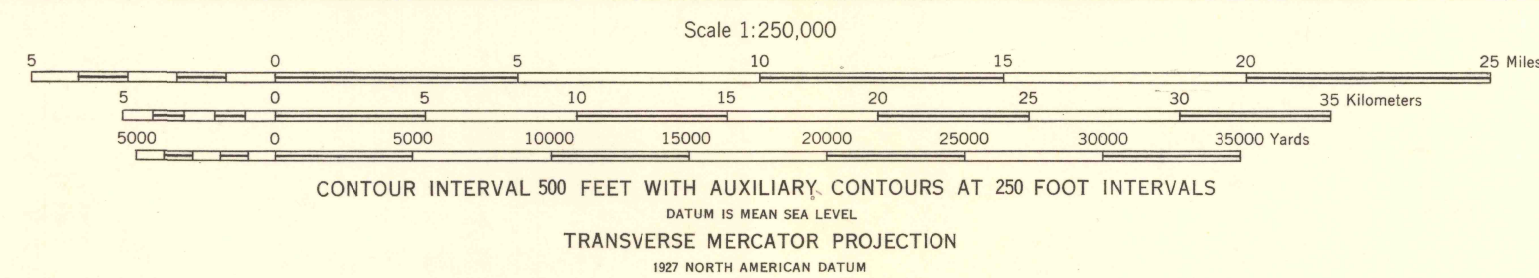

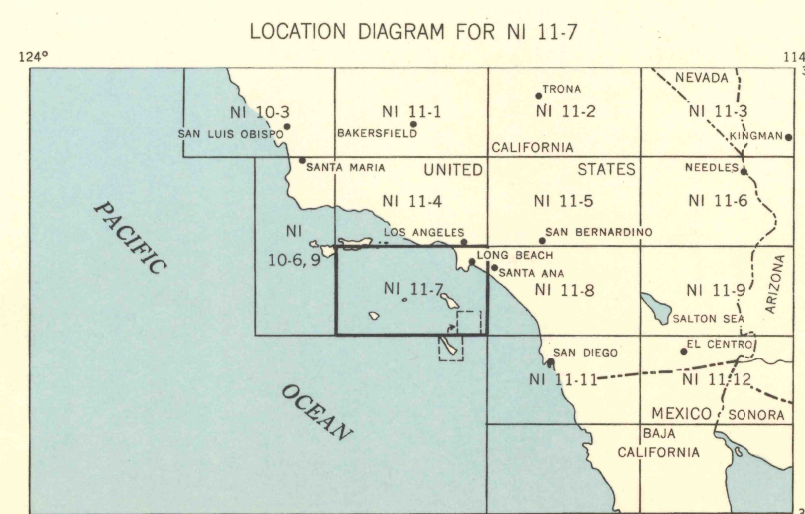


California Counties

4. Orange



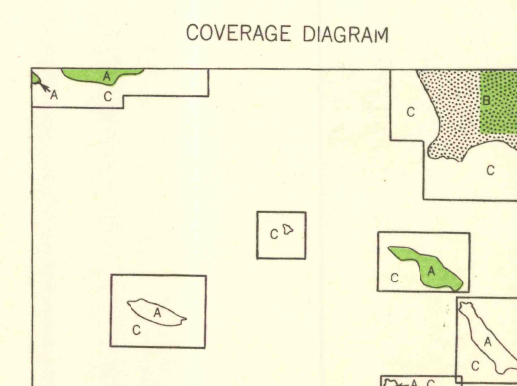
