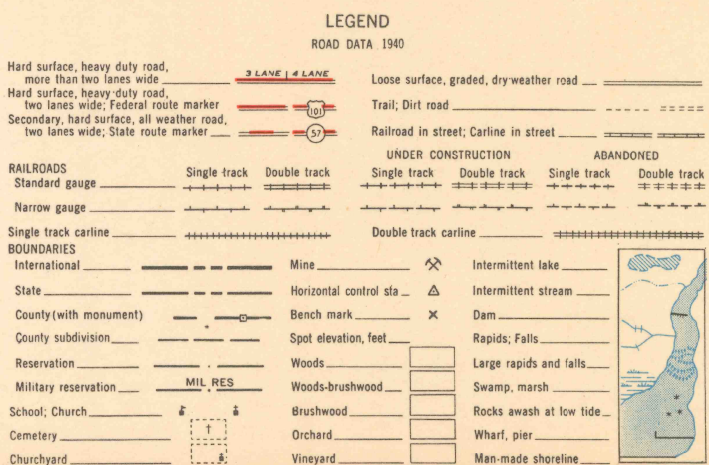

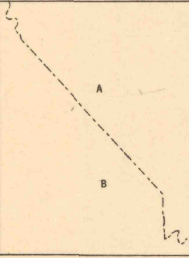


CONTOUR INTERVAL 50 FEET
DATUM IS MEAN SEA LEVEL

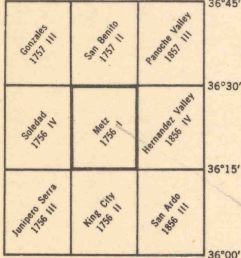
TRANSVERSE MERCATOR PROJECTION

INDEX TO BOUNDARIES

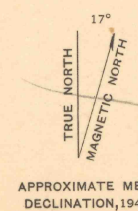


INDEX TO ADJOINING SHEETS
