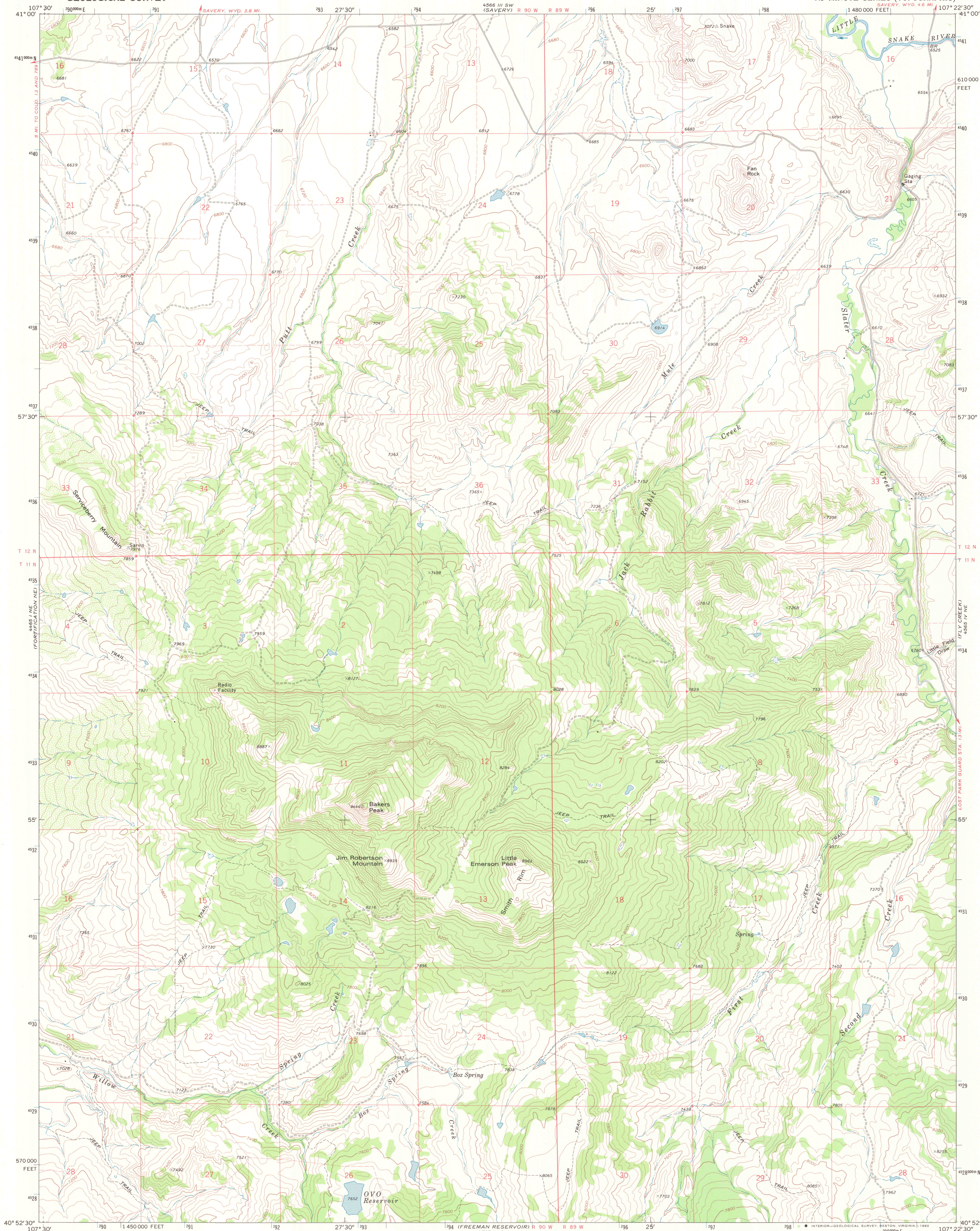

north zone

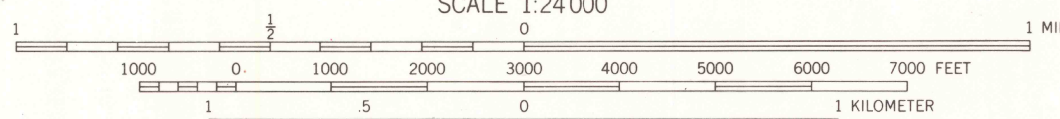
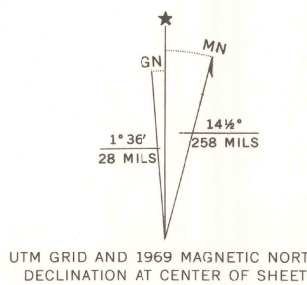
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines

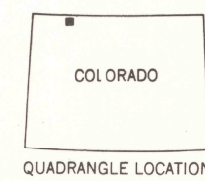
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983
