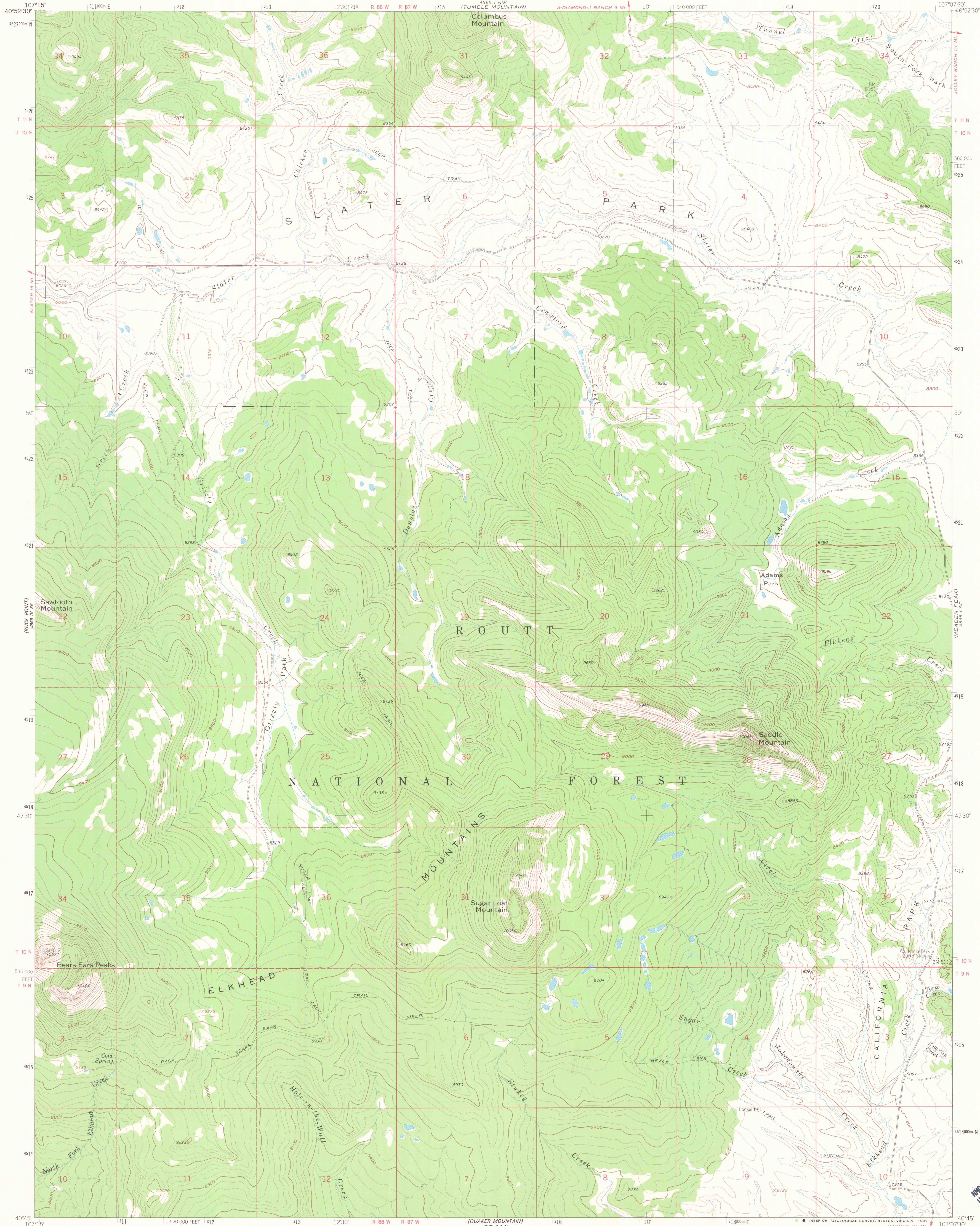




Mapped, edited, and published by the Geological Survey as part of the Department of the Interior program for the development of the Missouri River Basin Control by USGS

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 7 meters north and 52 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
