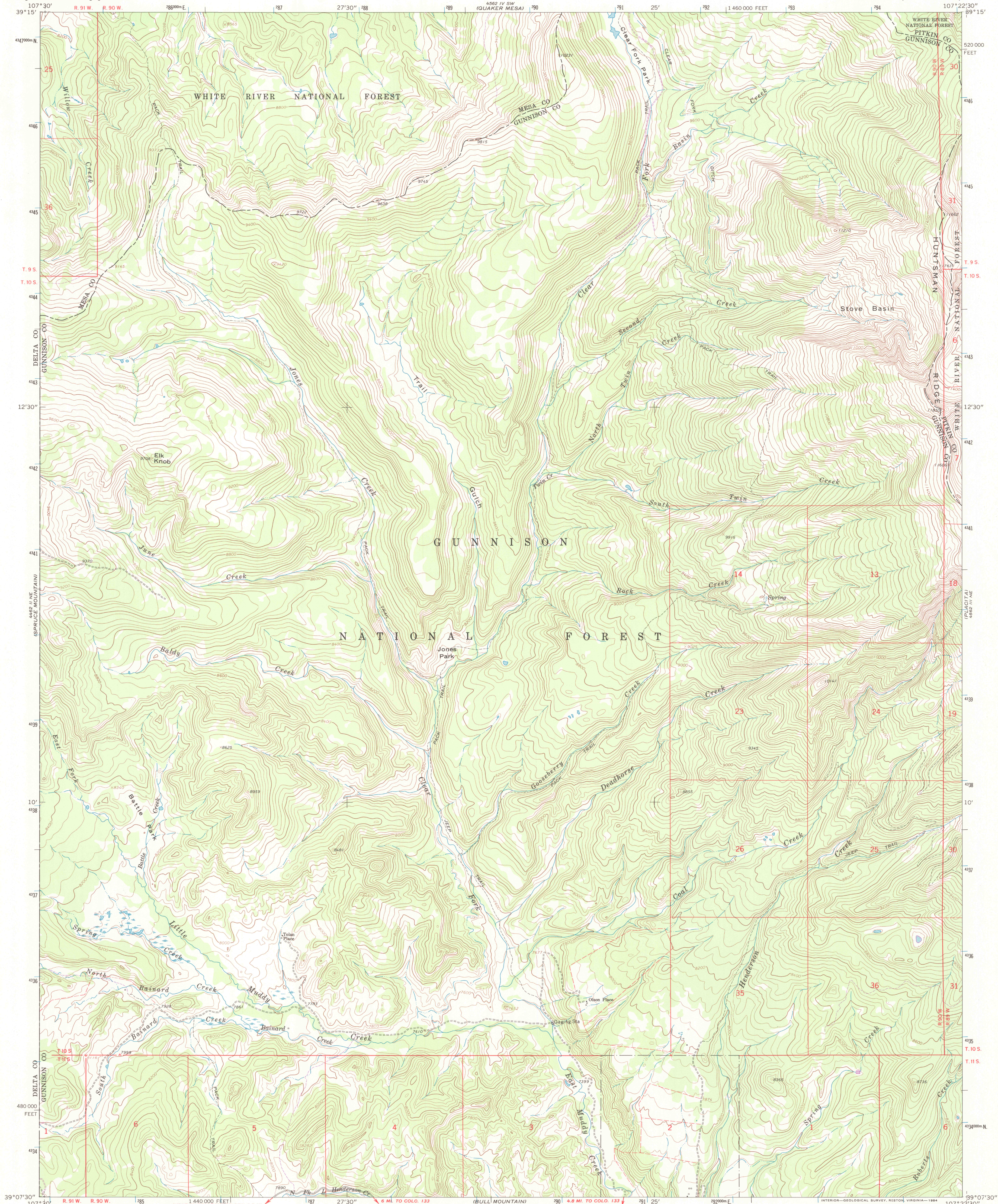

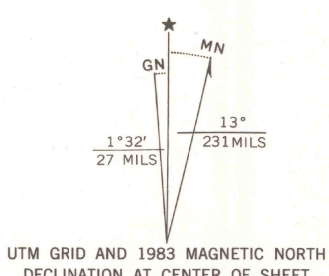

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue

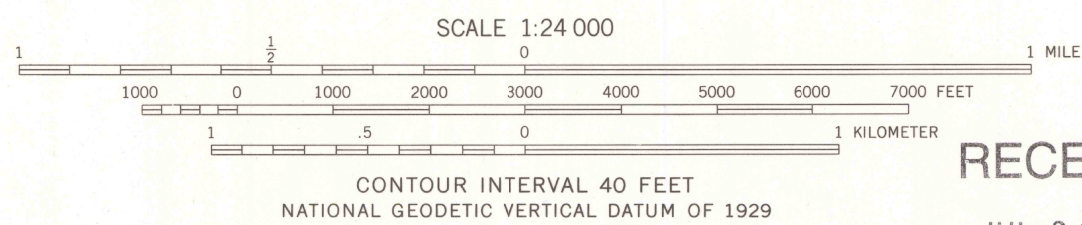
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines

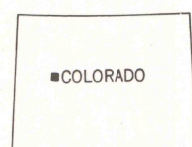
