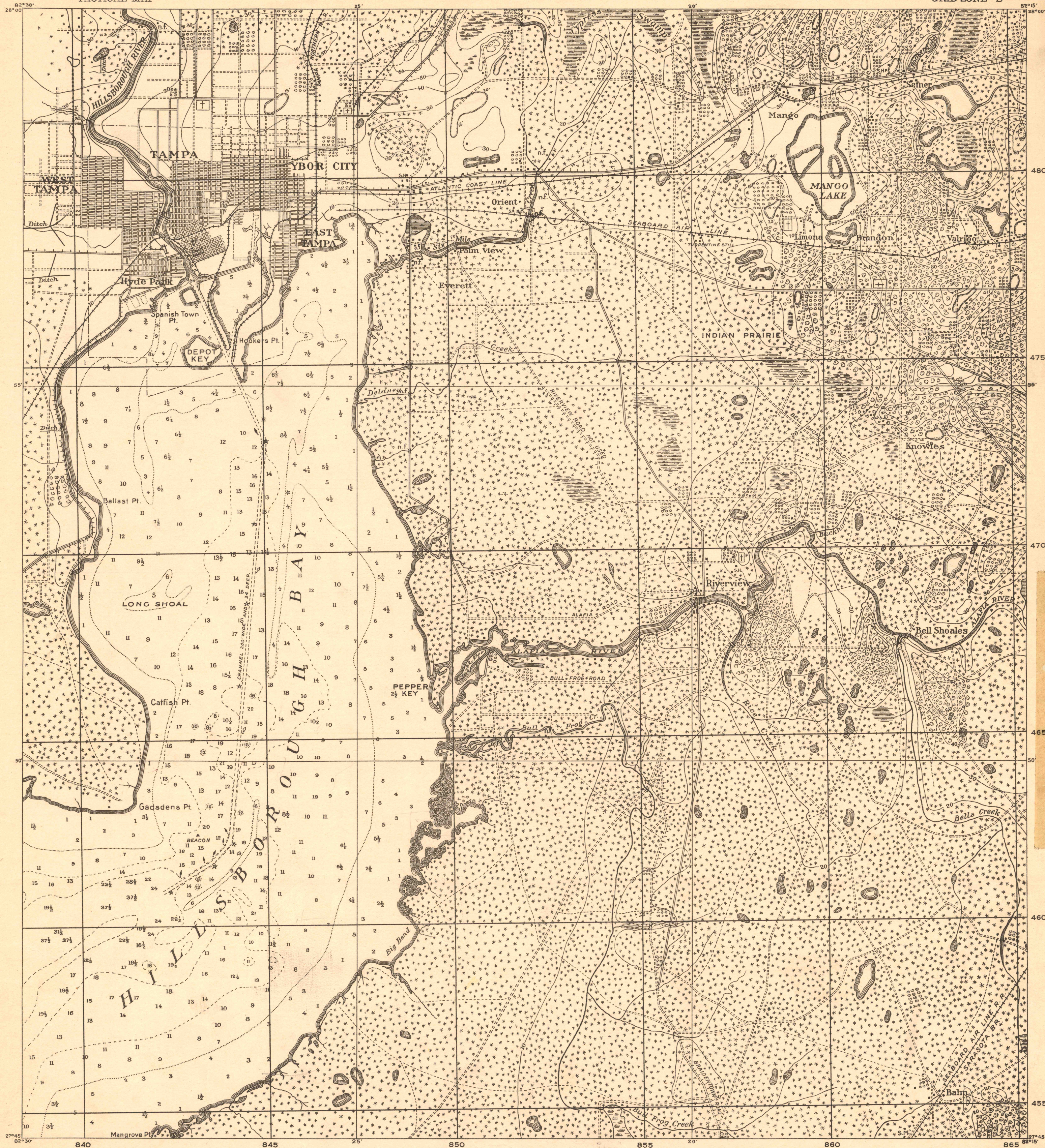




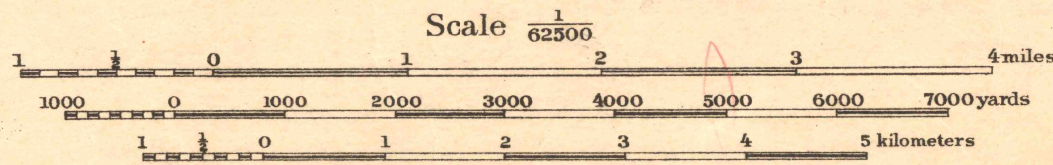

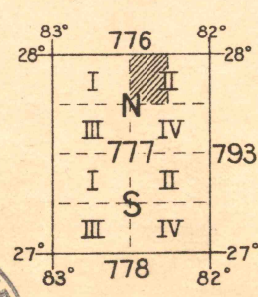
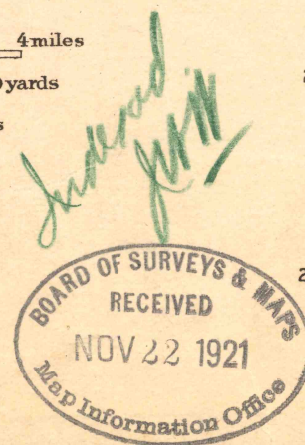
Soundings referred to mean low water
