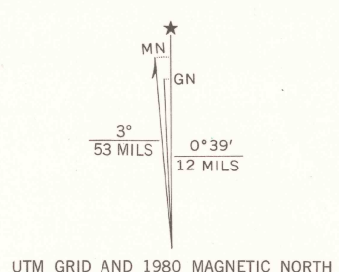
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 17, shown in blue. 1927 North American Datum
