

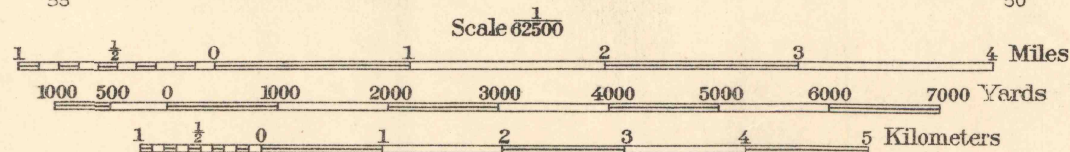

WASSAW SOUND QUADRANGLE



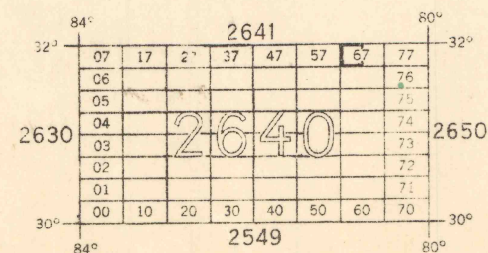
