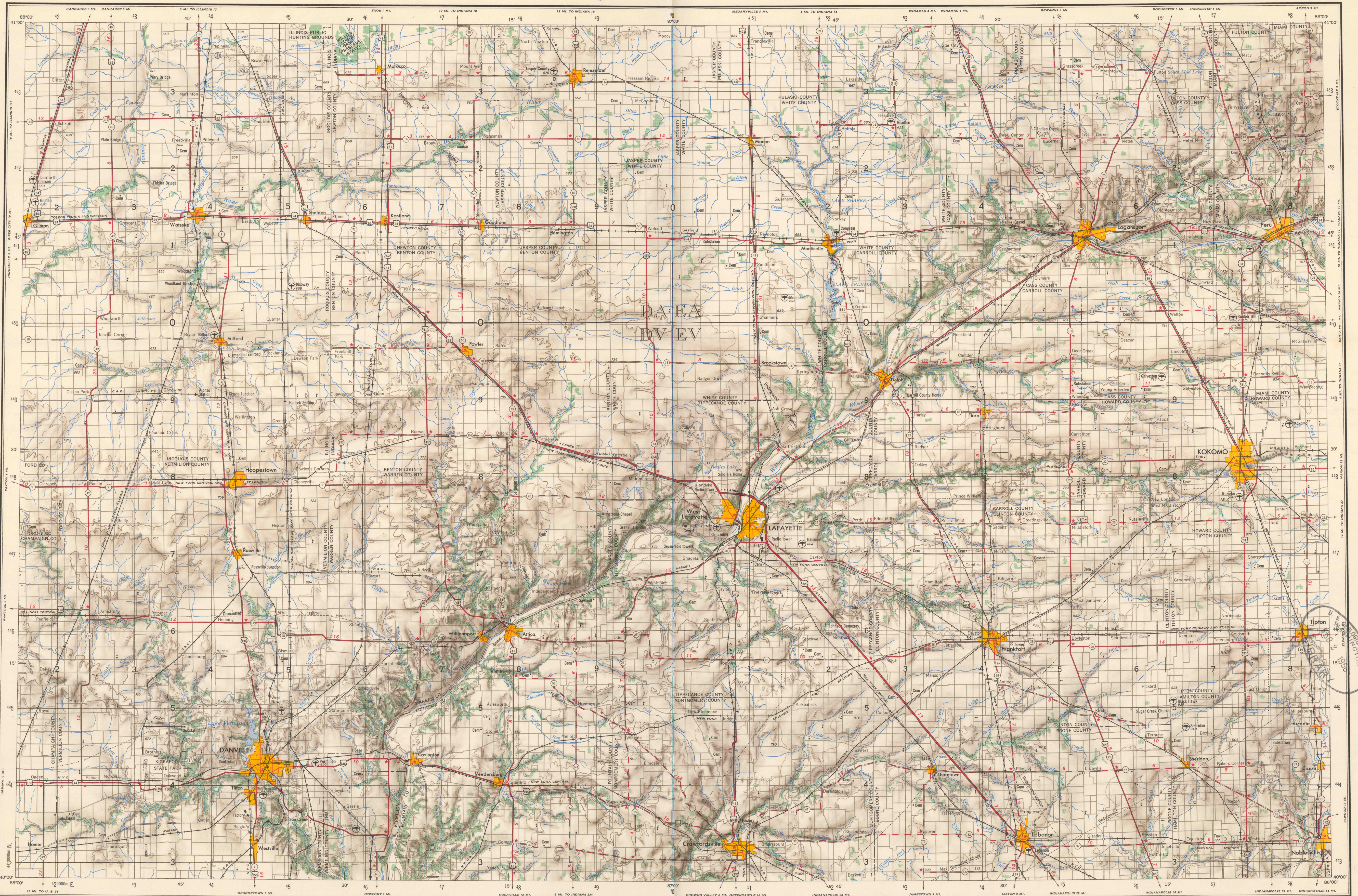

SAMPLE POINT: 16T000000

TO GIVE A STANDARD REFERENCE ON THIS SHEET TO NEAREST 100 METERS

1. Read tenths identifying 100,000 meter square in which the point lies.
2. Locate first TENTH and first 100 METERS on the line itself.
3. Estimate tenths from grid line to point.
4. Locate first HUNDRED, and line BELOW point and read LARGE figure labeling the line either in the left or right margin, or on the line itself.
5. Estimate tenths from grid line to point.
6. If reporting 10° in any direction, prefix Grid Zone Designation, etc.
