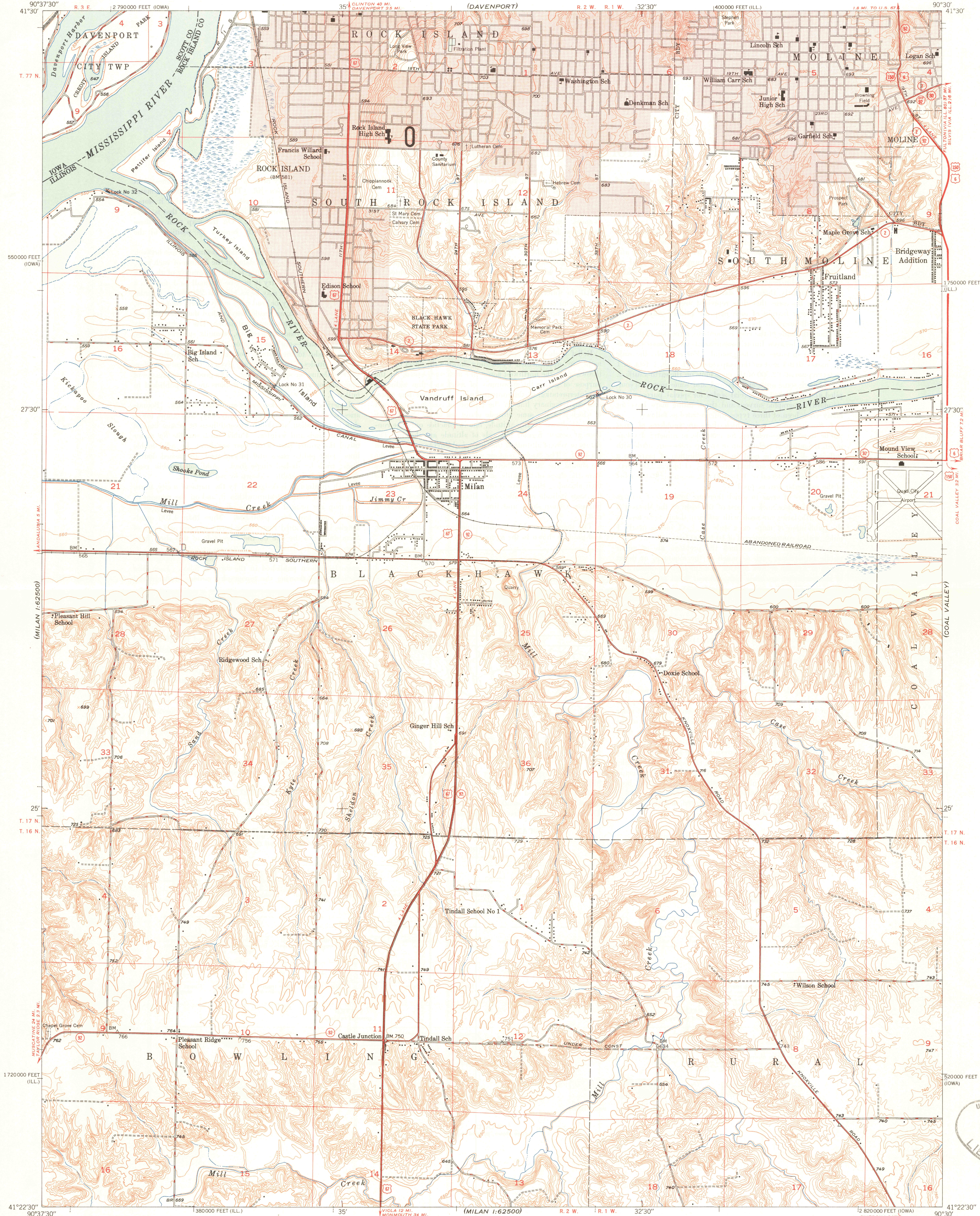

NE 1/4 MILAN 15' QUADRANGLE



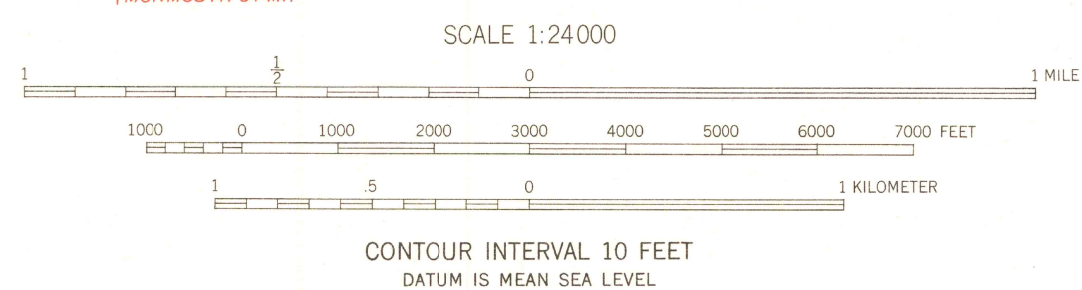
