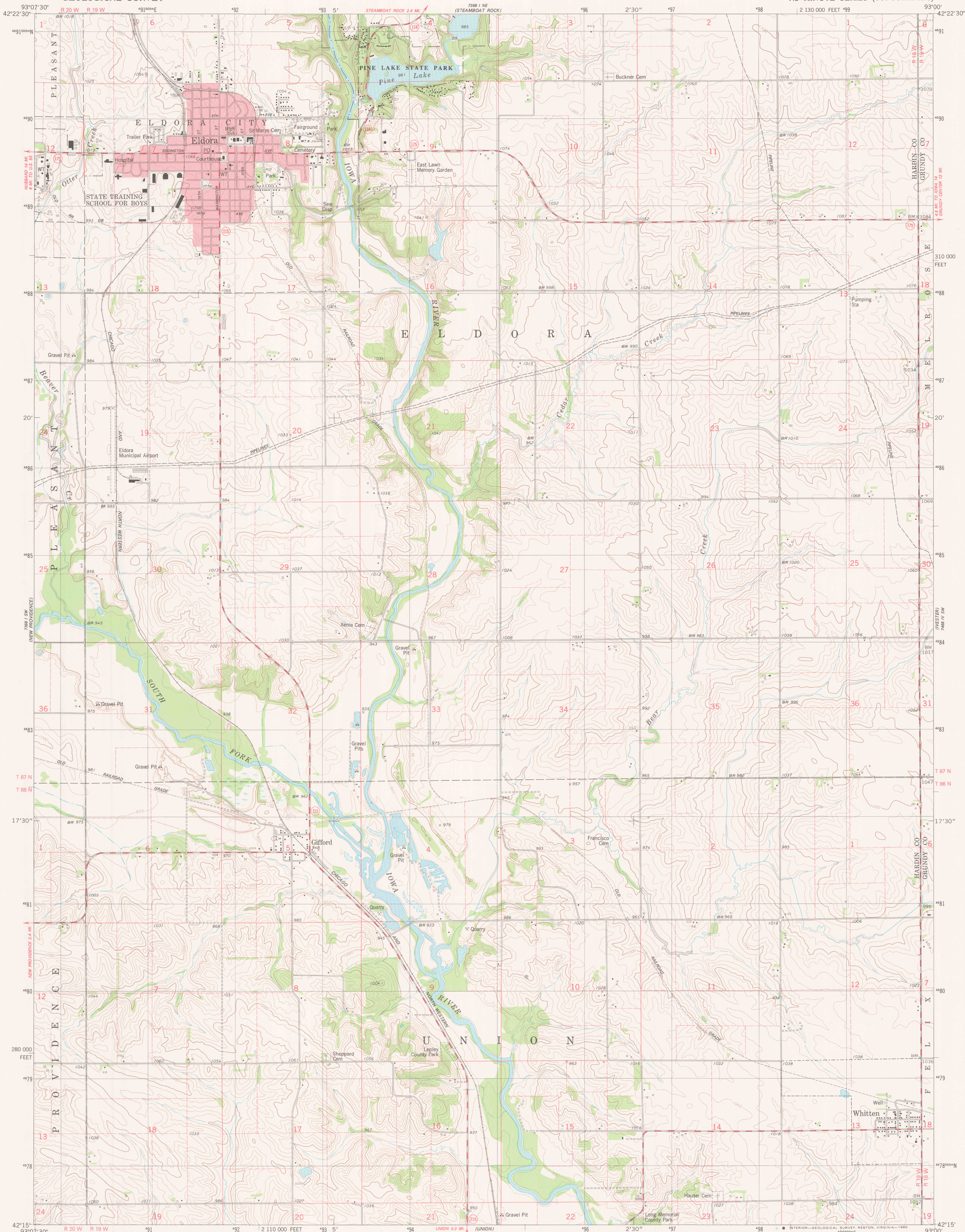

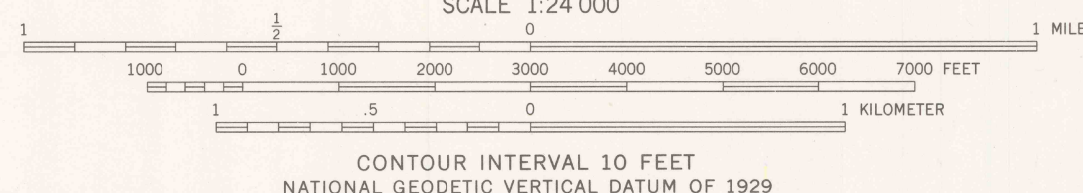
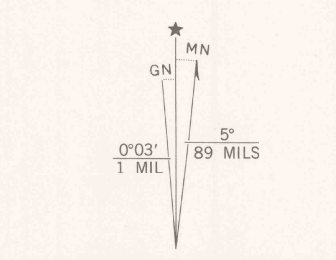
Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Iowa coordinate system, north zone (Lambert conformal conic)

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 4 meters north and 17 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

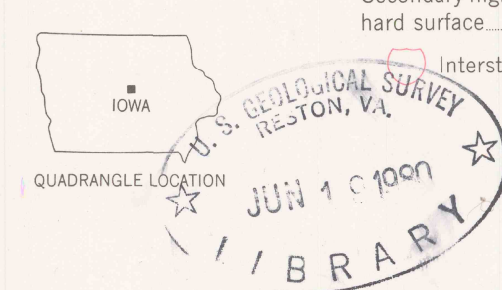
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map
