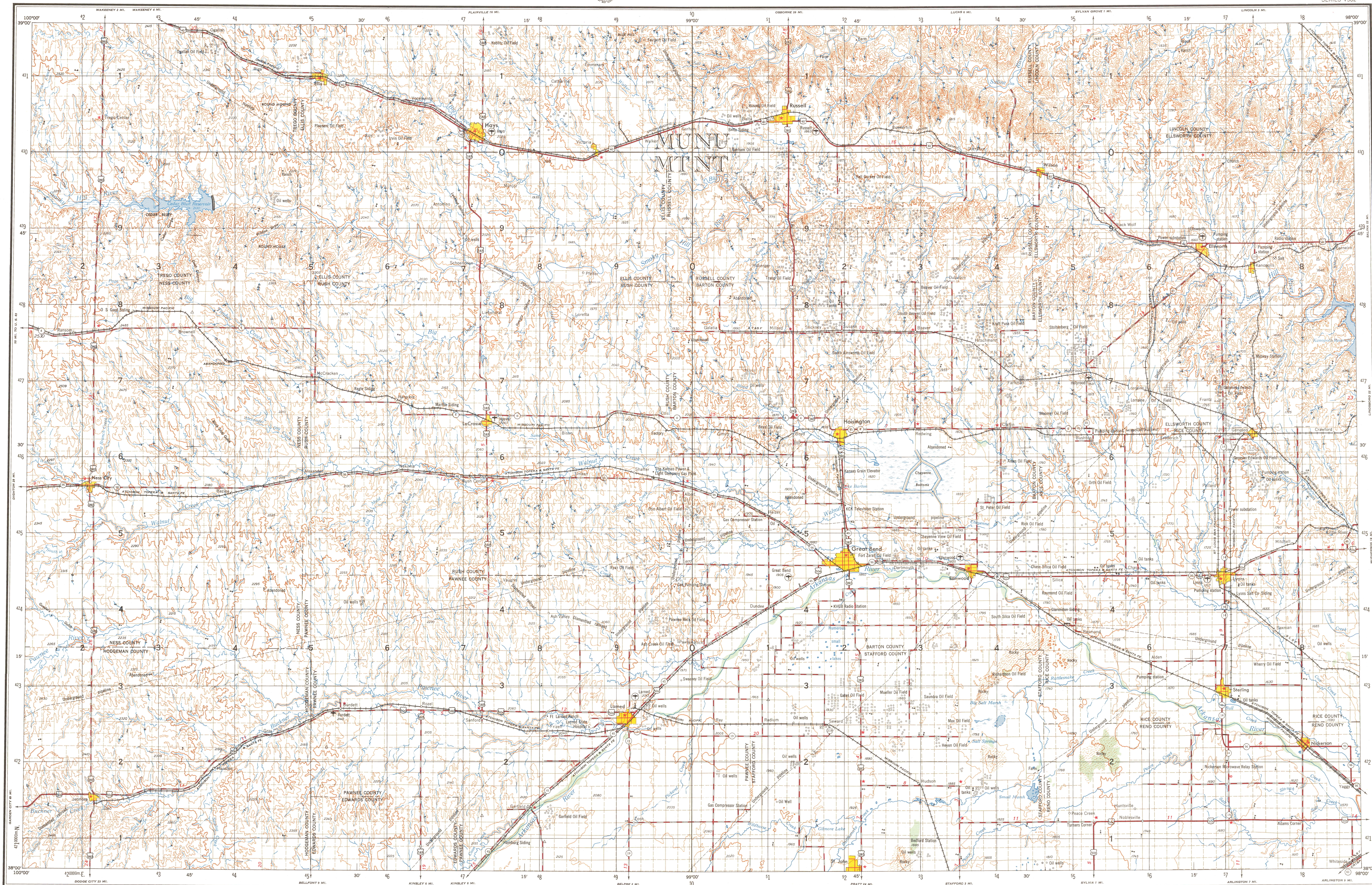

TO GIVE A STANDARD REFERENCE ON THIS SHEET TO NEAREST 1000 METERS

100,000 M. SQUARE IDENTIFICATION

SAMPLE POINT

1. Read letter identifying 100,000 meter square in which the point lies.

2. Locate first VERTICAL and line to LEFT of point and read LARGE figure labeling the line within the top or bottom margin, or on the line itself.

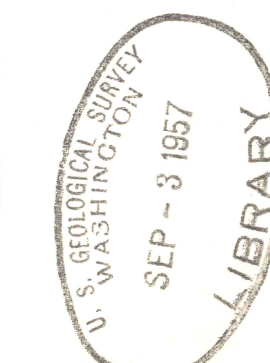
3. Estimate tenths from grid line to point.

4. Locate first HORIZONTAL and line below point and read LARGE figure labeling the line within the left or right margin, or on the line itself.

5. Estimate tenths from grid line to point.

SAMPLE REFERENCE:

If reporting beyond 10° in any direction, prefix Grid Zone Designation, e.g.: 145MT433
