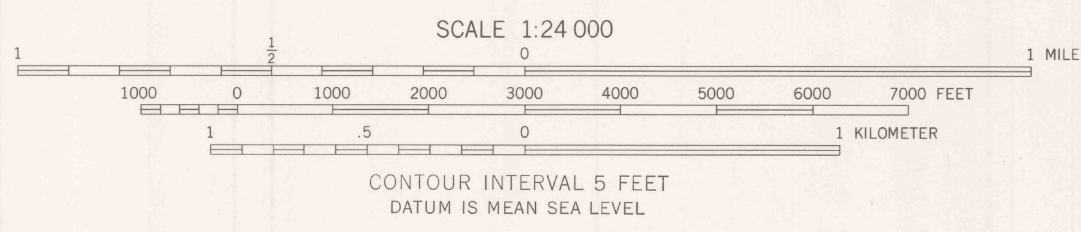


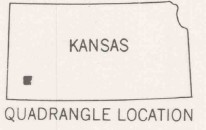


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Culture and drainage in part compiled from aerial photographs

generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked

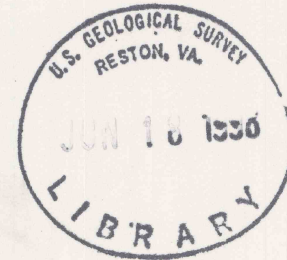
