

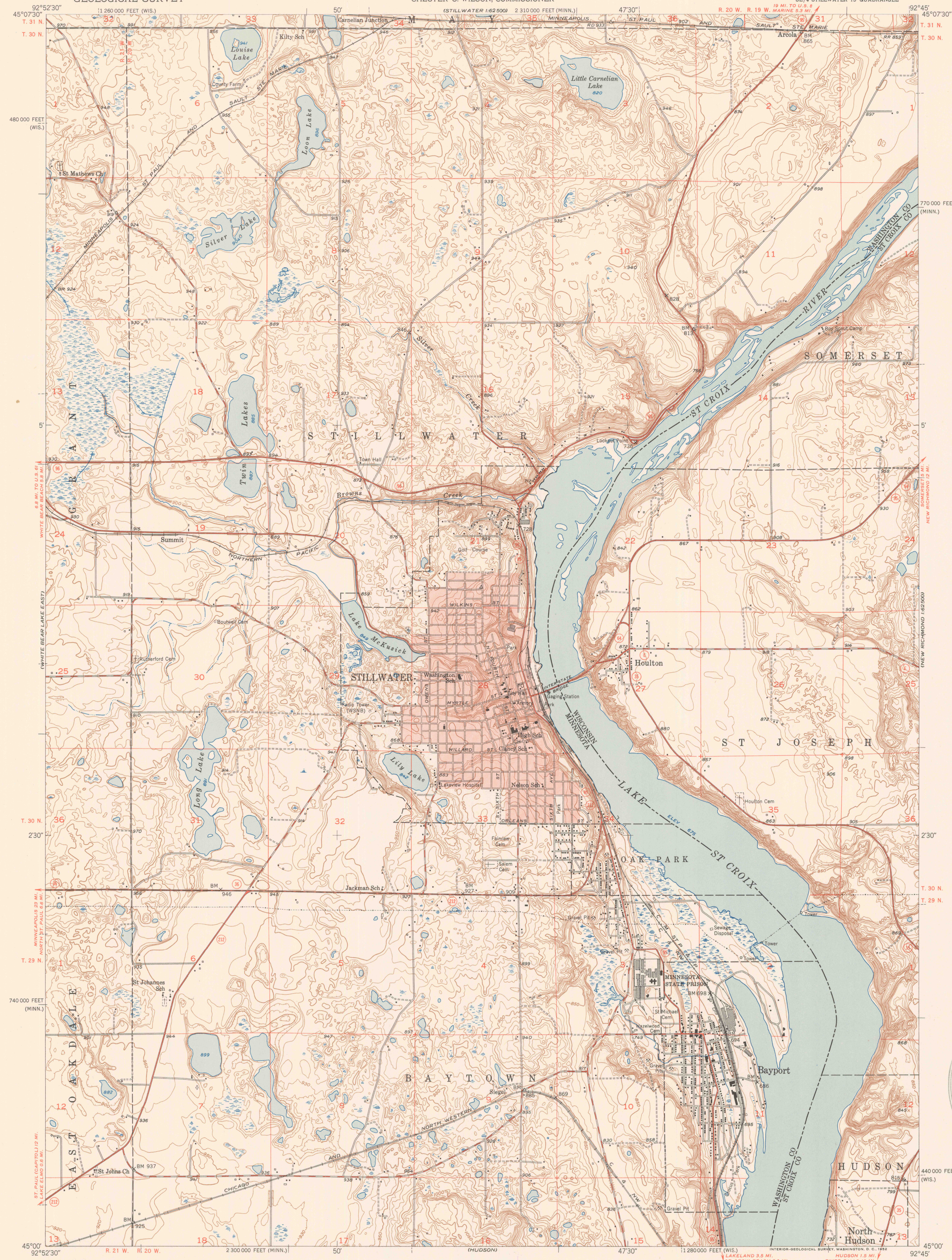

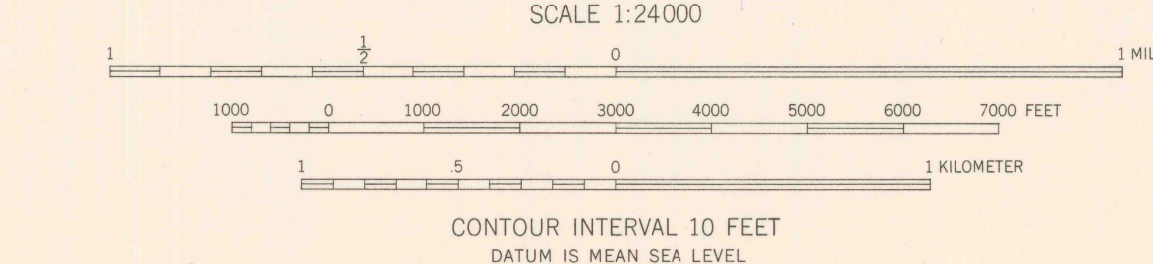
STILLWATER QUADRANGLE
