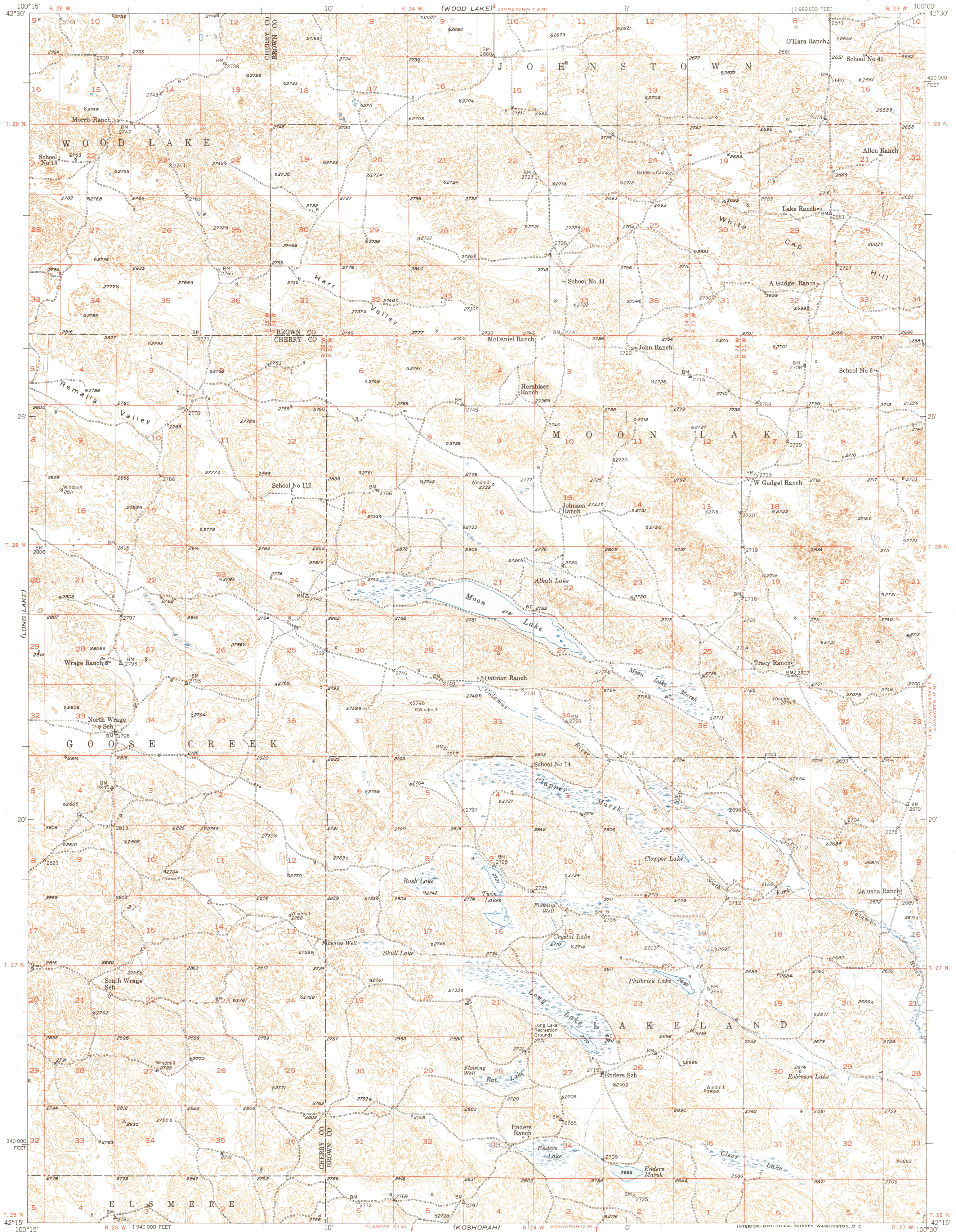

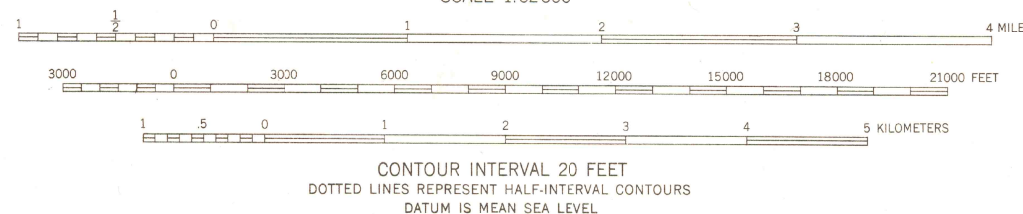
MOON LAKE QUADRANGLE
