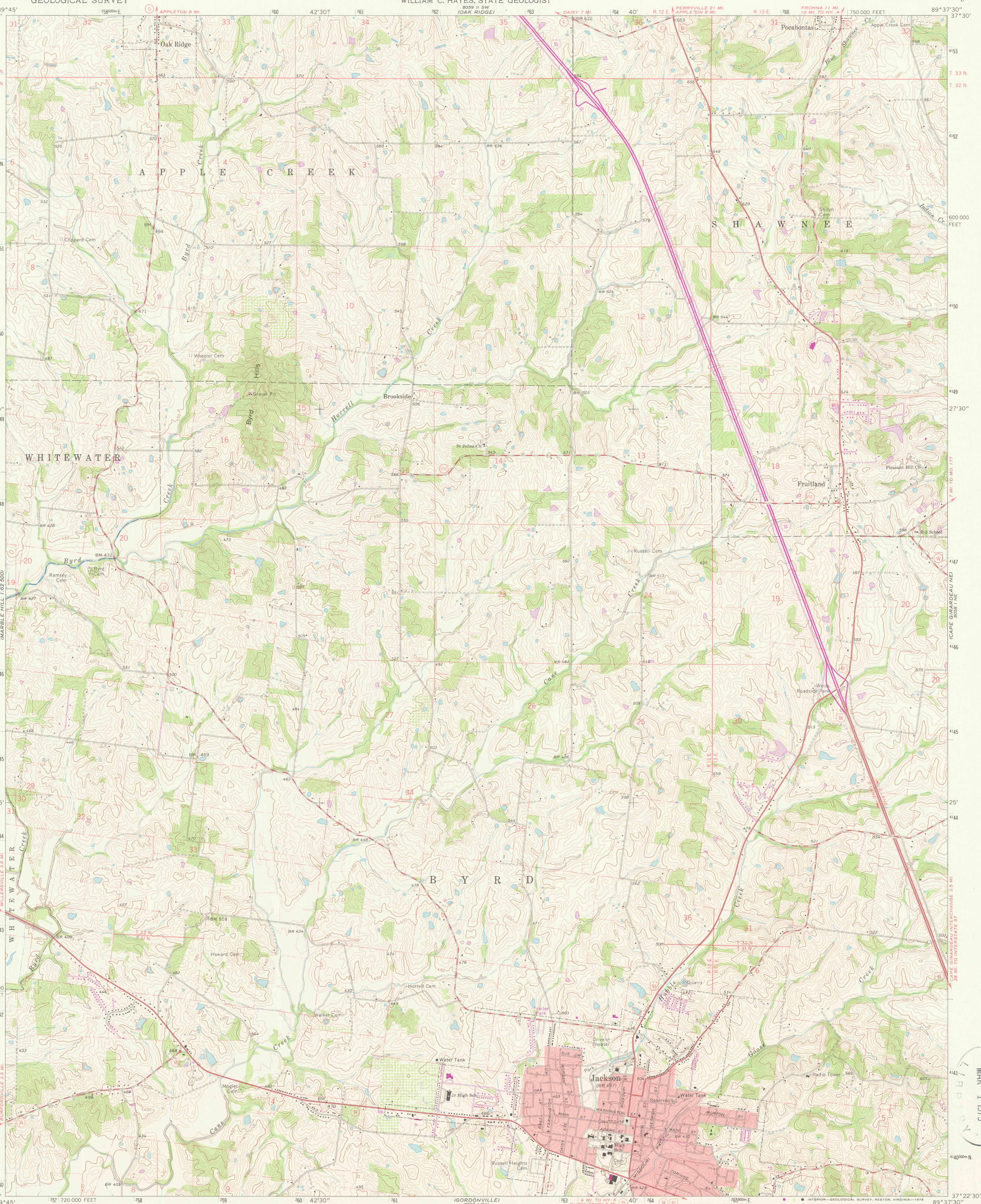

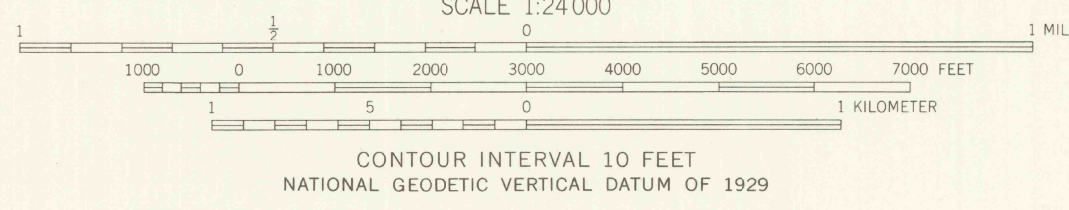
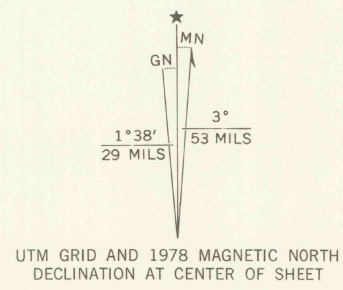
10,000-foot grid based on Missouri coordinate system, east zone
