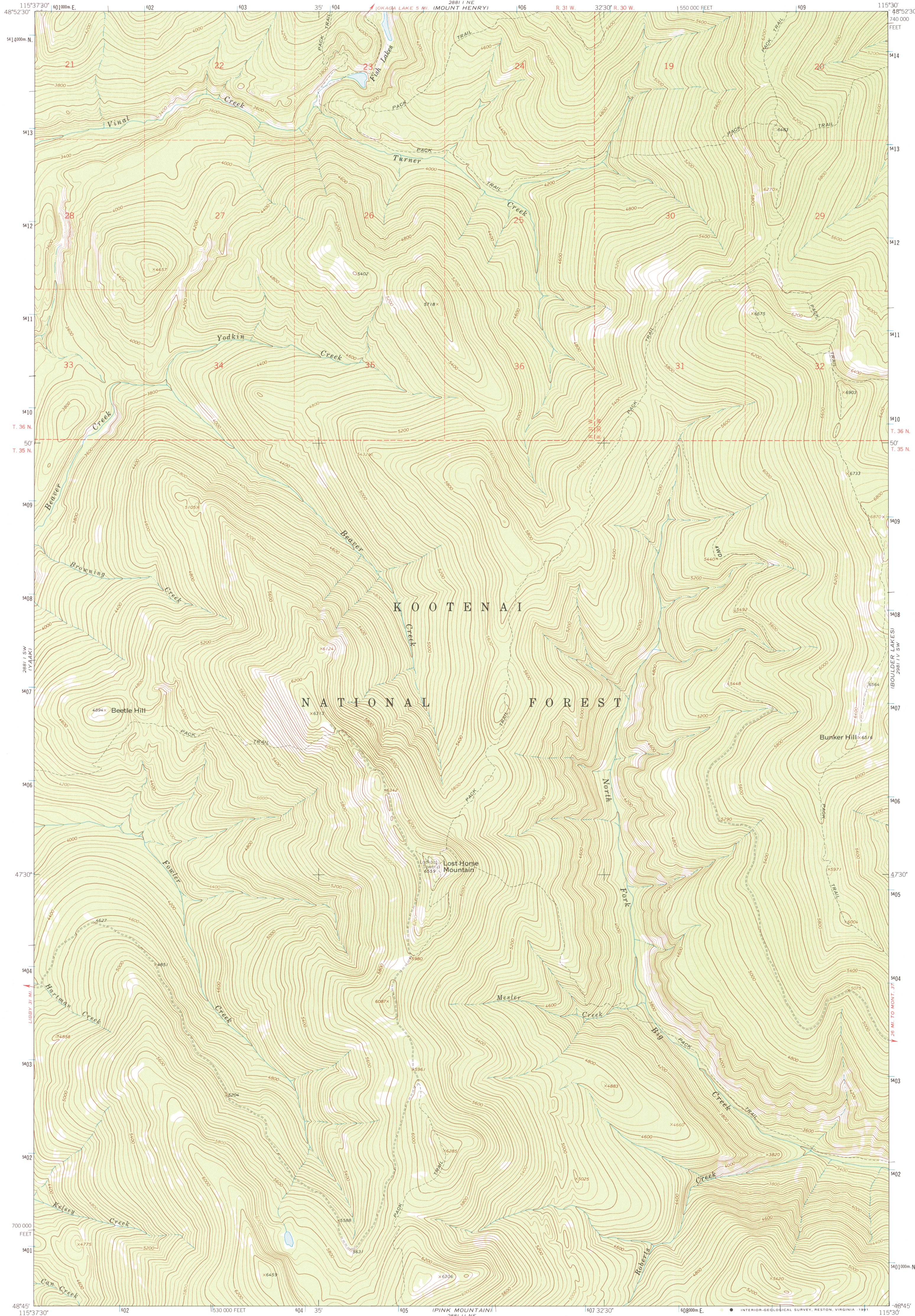

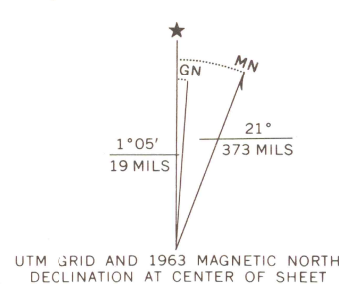

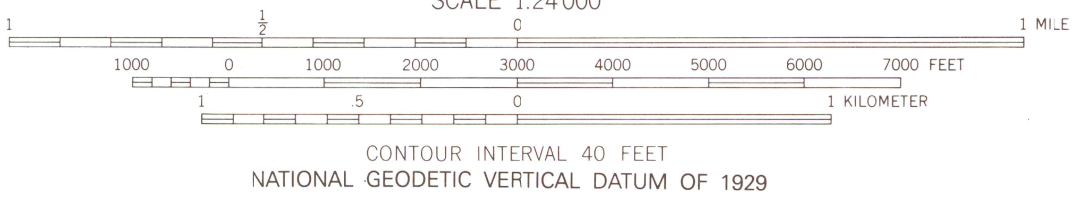
Polyconic projection - 1927 North American Datum
